The National Park System is dedicated to conserving the scenic, scientific, and historic heritage of the United States for the benefit and enjoyment of its people.

Camping offers one of the most enjoyable ways to see and become acquainted with the National Park System. It will be more enjoyable if you and all others observe all park regulations carefully. They are needed to protect natural and historic features and for your comfort and safety.

**Fires.** Fire is one of the greatest dangers to these areas. Fires may be kindled without special permit only at established picnic areas and campgrounds and then only in fireplaces. Do not go out of sight of your camp, even for a few minutes, without making sure that your fire is either out entirely or being watched.

**Wild animals.** In some areas, bears, deer, and other animals have apparently become accustomed to humans but they still are wild and may seriously injure you if you approach them. If left alone, the animals are seldom harmful. Many of them frequent the roads and some campgrounds. Food supplies should be kept locked up or suspended from tree limbs.

**Clean camp.** Keep your camp clean by burning garbage in your campfire, and by placing burned-out cans and residue in containers provided. If no container is provided, the refuse should be buried.

**Natural features.** Each area is a sanctuary for all living things. It is unlawful to destroy, injure, or disturb any form of plant or animal life, or any other natural, historic, or prehistoric feature.

## Fees

Except in trailer parks offering utility connections, there is no charge for the use of the campgrounds. However, in some areas of the National Park System, a fee is charged for entry of automobiles, house-trailers, and motorcycles. Revenue from these fees is deposited in the United States Treasury and offsets, in part, appropriations made for operating the areas.
