



# Fragmentation and Habitat Loss

In Theodore Roosevelt National Park, conversion of land for human development, such as agriculture, means the loss of vital homes for grassland birds. In addition, massive oil booms in North Dakota cause further fragmentation of native bird habitat.

# Exotic Invasives

The accidental and intentional release of Burmese pythons into the wild has decimated native bird populations in south Florida, including Everglades National Park and Big Cypress National Preserve.
