The DSC Library contains books, journals, government publications, videos, CD-ROMs, audio-cassettes and product samples. The Library acquires publications by or about the National Park Service. In addition, the Library collects publications on history, anthropology, architecture, engineering and preservation. Branch libraries house publications on engineering, building design and landscape architecture. Manufacturers' catalogs, building codes, standards and specifications are located in these libraries.

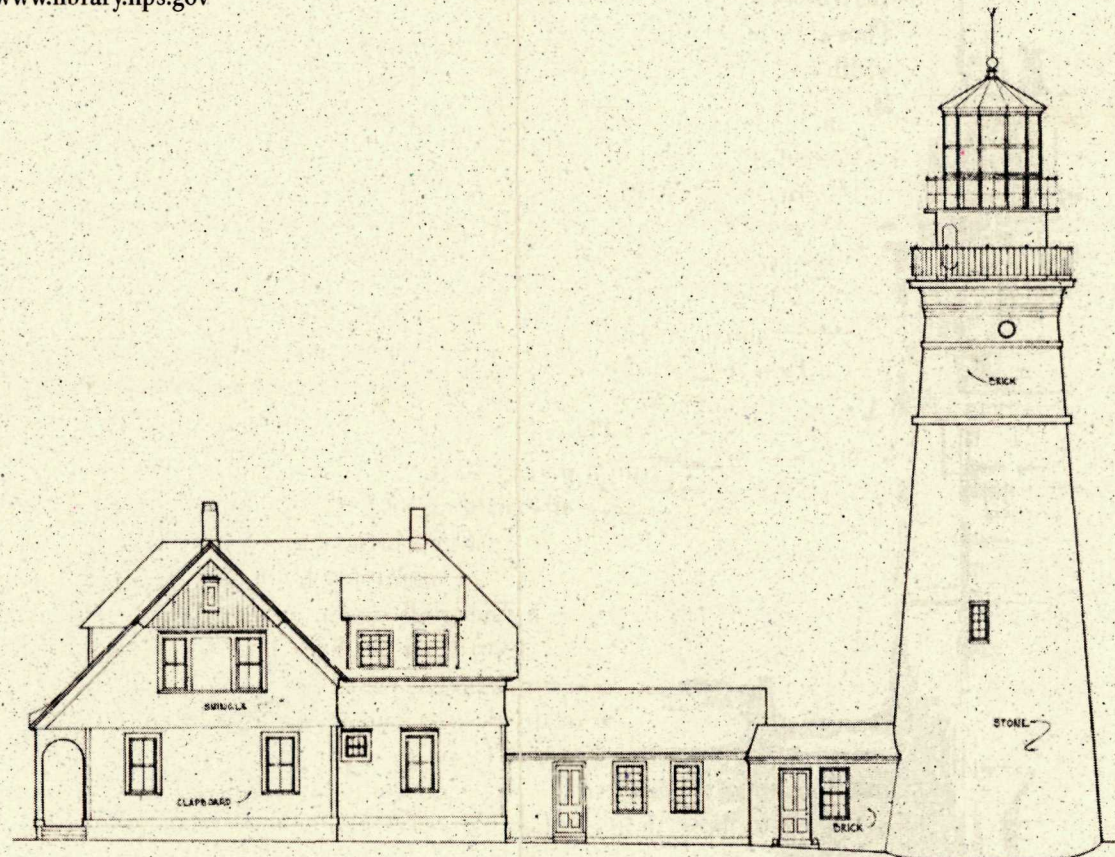

Library Services

Library services are available to all National Park Service (NPS) employees in the Intermountain Region and to Bureau of Land Management employees in the Cook Lakewood Building.

Access to Internet Reference Resources:

The Library maintains subscriptions to various online resources to assist NPS employees in obtaining full text standards, academic or scientific literature resources and accessing vendor catalogs.

Online DSC Library Catalog:

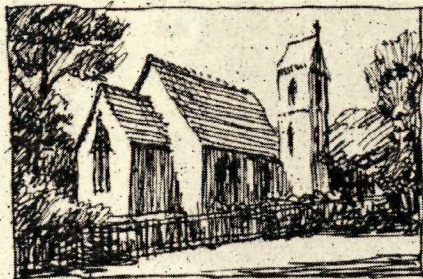
The DSC Library Catalog is part of the NPS Library Union Catalog via the Internet <http://www.library.nps.gov>. Search all the collections in NPS Libraries or restrict the search to those items in the DSC Library.

Online Literature Searches:

Library staff will do online searches of databases containing references to books, journal articles, dissertations and conference proceedings. NPS employees may then obtain materials identified for use through interlibrary loan.

Interlibrary Loan

Books and articles may be borrowed from other libraries in the United States and Canada. Articles are usually available within 24 hours. Book requests may take a week.



Internet Subscription Resources at the DSC Library

Information Handling Services (I.H.S.)

I.H.S. provides access to over 450 of the world's largest standards developing organizations. Search by standard number or keyword.

EBSCO Academic Search Premier and Business Source Premier

EBSCO provides access to current journal articles with full text available for over 6,000 journals.

OCCL FirstSearch

FirstSearch gives access to books, articles, dissertations, reports and conference proceedings on many subjects.

ASTM

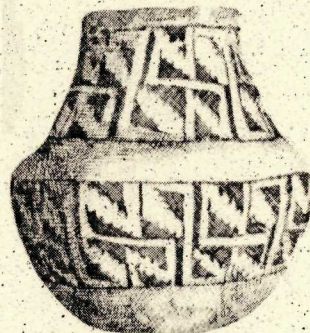
Pdf files of ASTM standards are available for immediate viewing and printing.

JSTOR

Full text archival access to botany and ecology journals is available.

NFPA

The National Fire Protection Association codes and publications are available in full text.

Cataloging and Consultation

The DSC Library staff will assist the Intermountain Region Parks in developing and managing their library collections. When park library collections are cataloged, the records will then be added to the NPS Library Union Catalog.
