Here in Southern California, most people live within an hour's drive of a national park (depending on traffic, of course!). Visit, explore, and fall in love with America's most treasured places.

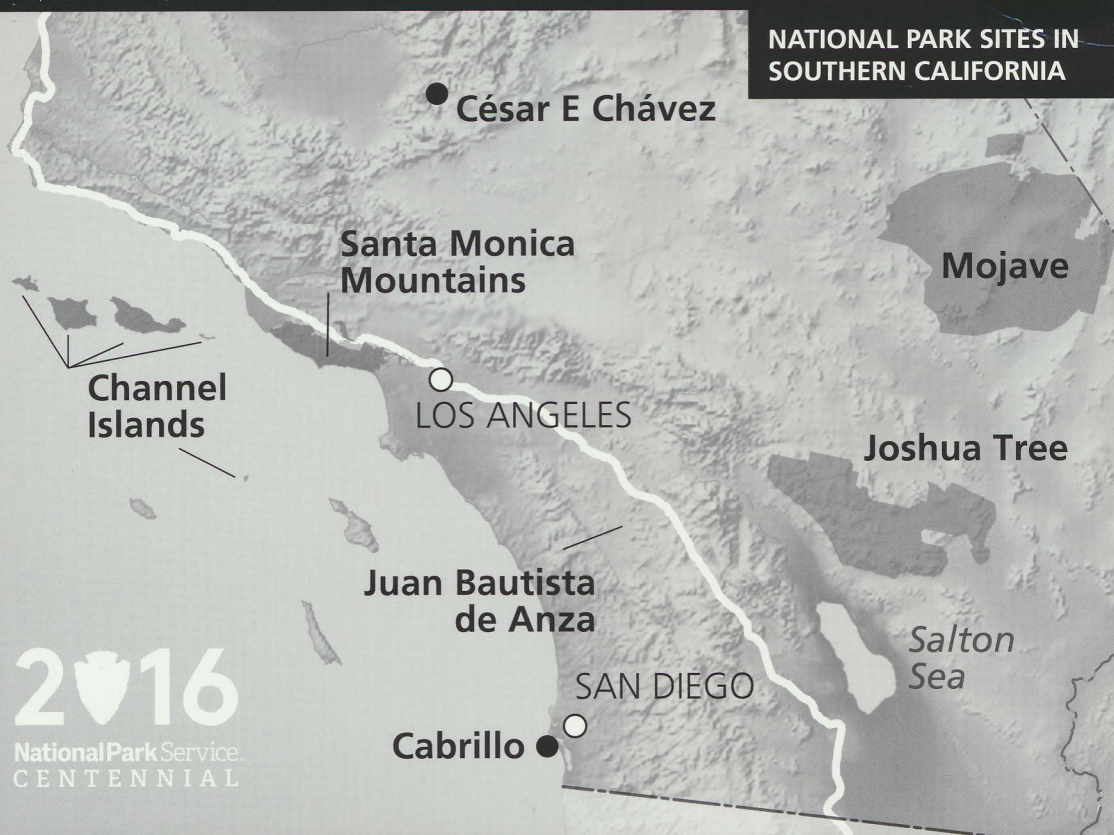
