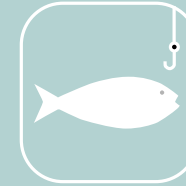

Fishing Regulations

Pee Dee National Wildlife Refuge

The Pee Dee National Wildlife Refuge is one of over 500 National Wildlife Refuges. The primary objective of a National Wildlife Refuge is to provide habitat for the conservation and protection of all species of fish and wildlife. Sport fishing is permitted at a level compatible with the environment, provides wholesome recreational opportunities, and permits the use of a valuable renewable resource.

Sport fishing on the Pee Dee National Wildlife Refuge is permitted only on the area designated by signs as open to fishing. The fishing waters comprise approximately 52 acres. See map on reverse side for approximate location of public fishing areas. The regulations listed below supplement the general regulations which govern fishing on National Wildlife Refuges as set forth in Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations.

Sport fishing will be in accordance with all applicable State regulations subject to the following special regulations.

Fishing is permitted during the daylight hours only.

Boats may be used in Andrews Pond, Beaver Ponds, and Arrowhead Lake.

Only electric motors are permitted.

Trotlines, set hooks and special devices are prohibited.

Parking is allowed only in designated areas.

Minnnows as bait are prohibited.

No littering.

All areas: March 15 - October 15

Note: Certain fishing areas may be closed early for duck banding or refuge operations.

Special Regulations

Fishing shall be in accordance with the following special regulations.

Refuge Fishing Season







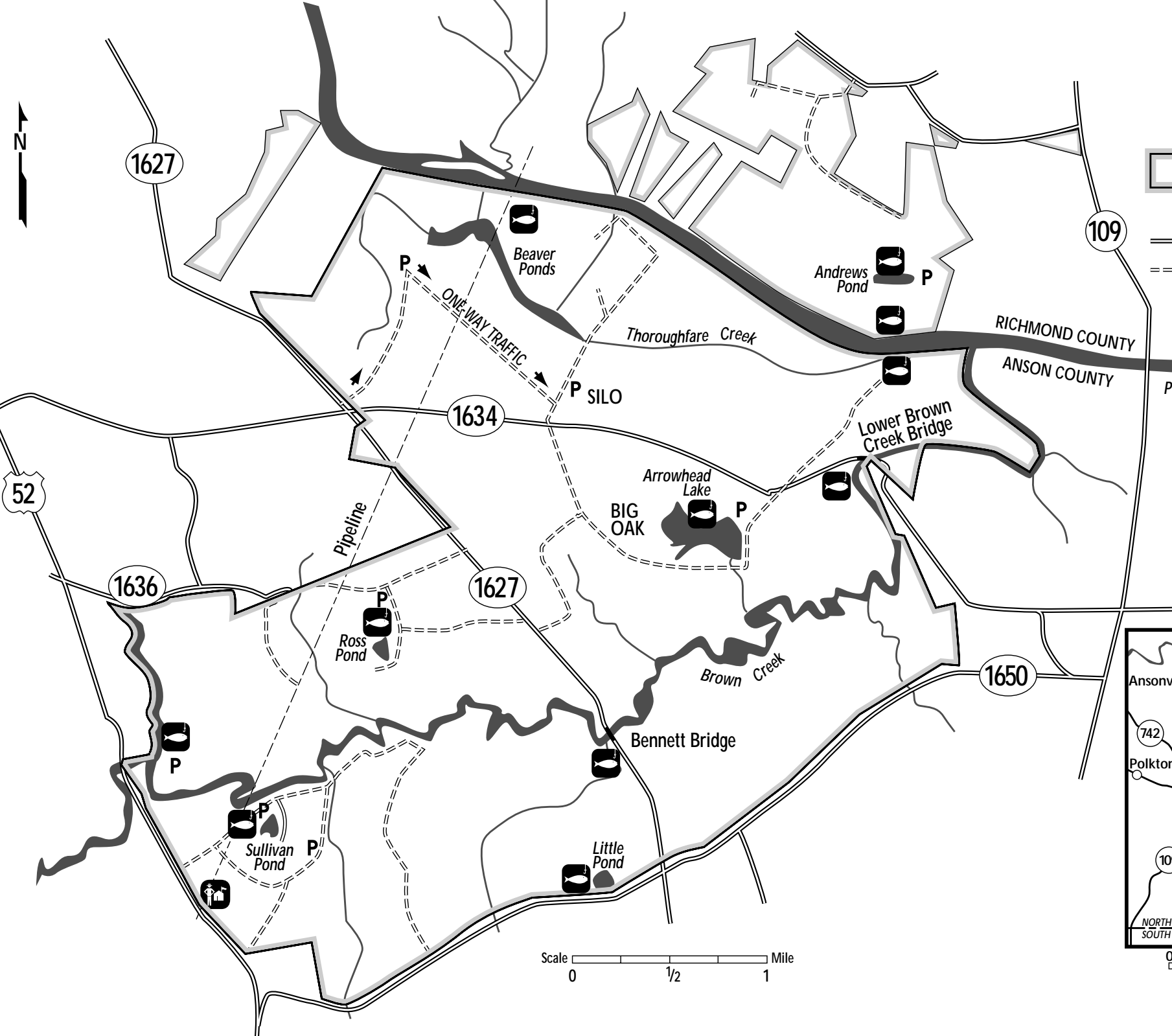
