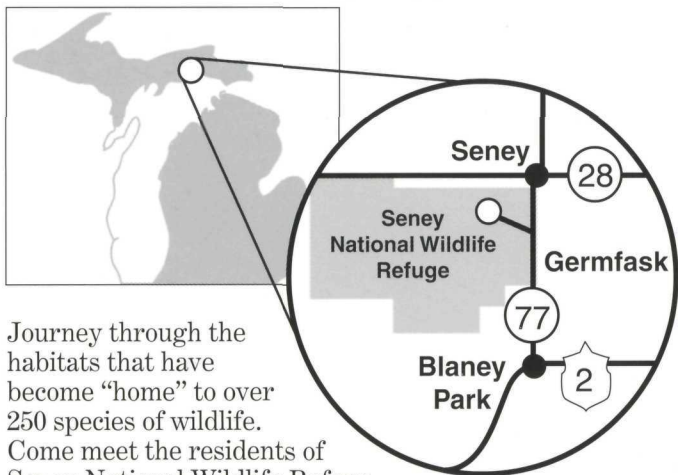

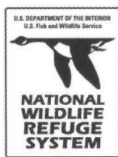
Touring by Car
