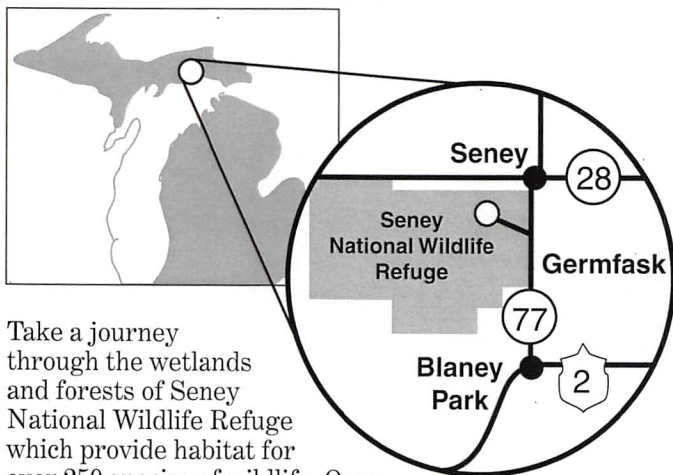

Take a journey through the wetlands and forests of Seney National Wildlife Refuge which provide habitat for over 250 species of wildlife. Open year-round, the refuge is a great place to view and photograph wildlife, hike, bike, paddle, and cross-country ski.

The Visitor Center is open daily from May 15 through October 20, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Exhibits include a touch table, loon diorama, the Marshland Bookstore, and "The Wonder of Nature" film. Nature programs are offered throughout the summer.

Touring by Car

The *Marshland Wildlife Drive* is a seven-mile, self-guided auto tour which winds its way past pools, pines and marshlands. It is open daylight hours from May 15 to October 20.
