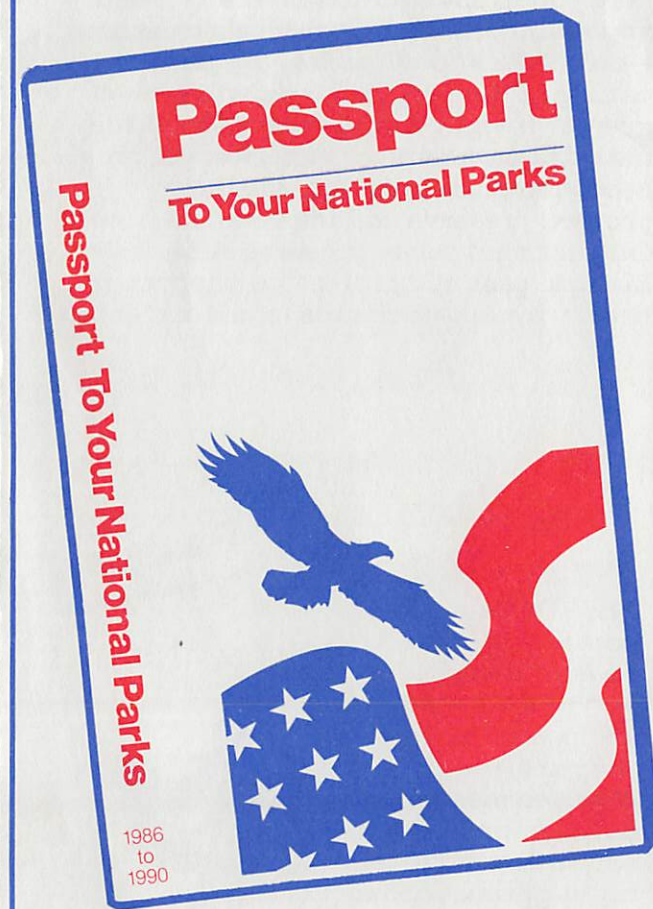

To Your National Parks

The Program

Passport to Your National Parks will help you to discover the diversity, beauty and history found in America's treasures—our 337 national parks. By participating in the program, you will gain a greater insight and appreciation of the national parks and of America. All proceeds from the program will help protect, preserve and improve the parks. Our national parks preserve America's historic past and protect its phenomenal beauty for all Americans to use and enjoy.

The Passport Book

The 104-page **Passport** is a 3½" x 6" booklet designed to serve as a constant companion to you—the park visitor. It features maps, park listings, photographs and interpretive text highlighting our national parks. The **Passport** book includes a nationwide map showing all nine geographic park regions. In addition, each chapter features a more detailed regional map with interpretive statements about parks within that region. The **Passport** is good for five years—from 1986 through 1990. **Passports** cost \$2.95 each.



Commemorative Stamps

Each year from 1986 through 1990, one national and nine regional commemorative stamps will be issued highlighting different park areas. The national stamp features a nationally significant event—e.g. the 1986 stamp honors the 100th birthday of the Statue of Liberty. National stamps are available at national parks throughout the country. Nine distinctive regional stamps will also be made available annually. They feature some of the most beautiful and historic spots in the country. All stamps will be available by mail order after October 1st of each year. The national stamp costs \$1.00, each regional stamp 50¢. There is a postage/handling cost when **Passport** and/or stamps are ordered by mail.



Cancellations

Within the **Passport** there is a section for you to get your book 'cancelled' whenever you visit a national park. These rubber-stamped ink markings record the name of the park and the date of your visit. Cancellations are found at most visitor centers and can be collected in the **Passport** through 1990. The cancellations are free of charge and you must visit the park to get your **Passport** cancelled; they are not available by mail order.
