The Passport Program

Passport to Your National Parks will help you to discover the diversity, beauty, and history found in America's national treasures - our 337 national parks. By participating in the program, you will gain a greater insight and appreciation of the national parks and of America. All proceeds from the program will help protect, preserve, and improve the parks. Our national parks preserve America's historic past and protect it's phenomenal beauty for all Americans to use and enjoy.

The Passport Book

The *Passport* book is a 3½" x 6" book designed to serve as a constant companion to you - the park visitor. It features maps, park listings, photographs, and interpretive text highlighting our national parks. The *Passport* book includes a nationwide map showing all nine geographic park regions. In addition, each chapter features a more detailed regional map with interpretive statements about parks within that region.

Cancellations

Within the *Passport* there is a section for you to get your book "canceled" whenever you visit a national park. These rubber-stamped ink markings record the name of the park and the date of your visit. Cancellations are found at most visitor centers and can be collected in the *Passport* through 1990. The cancellations are free of charge and you must visit the park to get your *Passport* canceled; they are not available by mail order.



Commemorative Stamps

Each year through 1990, one national and nine regional commemorative stamps will be issued highlighting different parks. The 1986 national stamp honors the 100th birthday of the Statue of Liberty and is available throughout the country. The 1986 regional stamps will be available only in parks within that region. All stamps will be available by mail after October 1 of each year.
