

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Visit [nps.gov](https://www.nps.gov) to find information on current park conditions and operations. Make a plan, have supplies on hand, and if you are sick, stay home.

KEEP IT CLOSE

Follow the state and county orders governing the open status of the area you are considering visiting. The National Park Service is working closely with governors and state and local health departments.

KNOW YOUR LIMITS

Postpone challenging hikes or trying new activities while first responders, parks, and communities continue to concentrate on responding to the pandemic.

KEEP IT WITH YOU

If you brought it, take it with you. Trash pickup and restroom facilities will continue to be limited in many areas of a park.

KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Recreate with those in your household. Give others plenty of room whether you are on a trail, on a city sidewalk, at a boat launch, or in a parking lot. Be prepared to cover your nose and mouth if you are near others.
