# Philip Sheridan Memorial

**Location:** Massachusetts Ave.  
& 23rd Street, N.W. **Dedicated:**  
**November 25, 1908**

Major General Sheridan engineered a key victory on October 19, 1864 at Cedar Creek, Virginia, which broke Confederate control of the Shenandoah Valley. Sheridan rallied his troops and changed a desperate retreat into a smashing victory. The memorial was sculpted by Gutzon Borglum, whose best known work is the monumental presidential heads of Mount Rushmore.
