Quebec born Lt.-General Drummond (1772-1854) was the colonial administrator and commander of the British troops in Upper Canada. He reinforced the troops in the Niagara peninsula and then led them to victory at Lundy's Lane. It was the decisive battle of the campaign and it was won by Drummond's persistence no less than that of his troops.
