COLONIAL NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

VIRGINIA



The primary features of the colonial-inspired park are Jamestown, site of the first permanent English settlement and the Yorktown Battlefield. The 23-mile long Colonial Parkway joins the two sites.

The essence of the tours, exhibits and children's activities presented at the sites and visitor centers, is portraying to visitors what life was like for the earliest Virginians. Self-guided tours are available by personal auto or by walking. Guided walking tours are offered as well. Picnic tables are available at Jamestown and Yorktown.

A fee is assessed per carload at Jamestown. School groups may be free with a written fee waiver. Contact the park for details. Yorktown does not charge a fee.
