North Cascades National Park Complex is one of pure, unblemished beauty. The snow-capped peaks of the Cascade Mountain Range are among the nation's most picturesque.

Few roads enter the park, however more than 300 miles of trails are maintained for hiking the interior which includes waterfalls, glaciers, wildflower meadows, lakes and streams.

The Park Complex is composed of three units: North Cascades National Park, Lake Chelan National Recreation Area, and Ross Lake National Recreation Area. Lake Chelan National Recreation Area, at the North end of Lake Chelan, is only accessible by hiking, boating, or float plane. More accessible is Ross Lake National Recreation Area where Ross, Gorge and Diablo lakes are the center of visitor activities.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Summer storms bring on dramatic temperature changes; beware of hypothermia. Crossing streams can be hazardous. Crossing snowfields may require special equipment.
