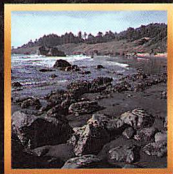

All of Redwood National Park is quite beautiful, but undoubtedly its most fascinating feature is the redwood trees known as *Sequoia sempervirens*. These are not only the tallest of all trees, they are the tallest living things on the planet. Unlike its relative, the giant sequoia which rules as the largest living thing by volume, the redwood reigns as the tallest of living things.

These monarchs are a soaring 200 to 240 feet. In the Tall Trees Grove along Redwood Creek you'll find the very tallest, towering a neck-craning 367.8 feet!
