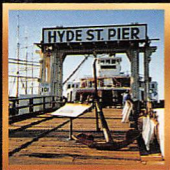

This park includes a fleet of ships, a two-story Maritime Museum, and a Maritime Library. Visitors tour the 1886 square-rigger *Balclutha*, the 1895 coastal schooner *C. A. Thayer*, and other historic vessels at Hyde Street Pier. Pier activities include steam engine demonstrations, crafts, living history and boatbuilding. The Museum contains exhibits, models, sailer craftwork, ships figureheads and fine arts. The research Library provides public access to rare books, current periodicals, and thousands of photographs. The park also contains a grassy picnic area with a spectacular view of San Francisco Bay.
