A seafaring spirit rings out at Salem Maritime National Historic Site. Walk the waterfront Heritage Trail, tour finely appointed period homes, or dress up like a sailor.

Touring the nine-acre site reveals much about the Salem merchants' penchant for overseas luxury trade. Several decades of eastern sea voyages resulted in prosperous trading of exotic goods and related industries. This became the very livelihood of the maritime settlement.

The Hatches and Derby Wharves, the 1819 U.S. Custom House and Derby Wharf Lighthouse are some of the fascinating structures visitors may tour. The visitor center provides information about this Site and others in Essex County.
