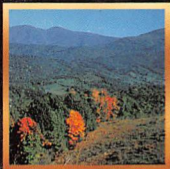

## SHENANDOAH NATIONAL PARK

LURAY, VIRGINIA

The Blue Ridge Mountains are the major feature of the park. These smoky blue majesties are surrounded by the Shenandoah River, vibrant forests, waterfalls and meadows.

Seasonal changes bring great color and diversity to the forests and meadows, especially in spring and fall.

The scenic Skyline Drive is a 105-mile road spanning the Blue Ridge with many panoramic overlooks of the Shenandoah Valley, mountains and other points of interest. Visitors enjoy hiking some of the 500 miles of trails, relaxing in campgrounds, picnic areas and seeking out Shenandoah's natural and cultural treasures on ranger programs and walks.
