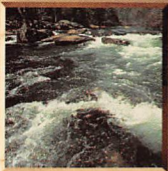

## OBED WILD AND SCENIC RIVER

TENNESSEE



Approximately 45 miles of river are comprised of the Obed River, Clear Creek, Daddy's Creek, and Emory River. These water courses have cut a rugged landscape leaving exciting whitewater gorges with bluffs as much as 500 feet above.

### **SPECIAL INFORMATION**

Whitewater paddling, Class II - V, is permitted in and around the park, however, boaters need to know their experience level and water conditions before putting on the river. Swimmers should be aware that rivers have moving currents and can be dangerous, especially during high water. One primitive campground is located in the Nemo area of the park. Hiking trails are limited. Rockclimbing is also done in the Lilly area. Hunting and fishing is permitted. • Superintendent, Obed Wild and Scenic River, P.O.
