Lincoln Memorial

Location: Independence Ave. & 23rd Street, S.W.

Dedicated: May 30, 1922

The memorial is the supreme illustration of the nation's esteem for its 16th president. Elements of unity and freedom adorn its majestic interior and exterior walls. The president's statue looks to the east capturing in his gaze a symbol of the Union, the dome of the U.S. Capitol, completed at his order during the Civil War.
