



Winfield S. Hancock Memorial

Location: 7th Street &
Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

Dedicated: May 12, 1896

Embodying his nickname "Hancock the Superb," this Union hero gallantly led troops during most of the struggles of the Army of the Potomac. Perhaps his finest hour came at Gettysburg where he led troops engaged in all three days of fighting including those that repulsed "Pickett's Charge" on the battle's final day. The dedication of Hancock's memorial in 1896 was attended by President Grover Cleveland.
