Private Henry Hall traded this militia coat in for a Confederate uniform as he headed south with the Fourth Kentucky Infantry, CSA. Sadly, he died on January 2, 1863. His coat and a letter to Henry's mother describing him as "A good boy and a good soldier," are on display in the park museum.
