Your National Parks Pass

The National Parks Pass is your official entry pass to enjoying America's National Parks—places like Yellowstone, Everglades and Denali, as well as hundreds of other Parks, historic sites, battlefields, recreation areas and seashores across America. There are nearly 400 places in all to choose from!

The 2006 National Parks Pass is valid for admission at all National Parks that charge an entrance fee. For an additional \$15, you can purchase a Golden Eagle sticker at any federal recreation site that charges an entrance or standard amenity fee. The Golden Eagle sticker upgrade will make your National Park Pass valid at federal public lands administered by U.S. Forest Service, Fish and Wildlife Service, Bureau of Land Management and Bureau of Reclamation. For more information about other federal public lands, including campground and tour reservations, visit www.recreation.gov.

The National Parks Pass does not cover fees for certain guided tours of historic homes or caves, parking or camping fees. In addition, many Parks do not charge admission. For more information about fees at the National Park you will be visiting, check www.nps.gov.

The National Parks Pass is valid for one full year from first use in a National Park. If the Pass is not used, it will expire on December 31 of the year listed on the back of the Pass. The Pass is not transferable. Lost or stolen National Parks Passes cannot be replaced. A valid photo ID is required when presenting the National Parks Pass.



Important Notes

When you see the Parks Pass icon in this Owner's Manual, it indicates that the Park requires an entry fee and that your Pass will provide admission in lieu of this fee.

When you see the (HQ) abbreviation in this Owner's Manual, it indicates that the city listing corresponds with a separate headquarters office for the Park. It is not a geographic reference point. For example, the city listing for Saint Croix Island IHS in Maine (Map 1) is Bar Harbor, which refers to the HQ office in Acadia National Park. Therefore, Acadia would be the primary point of contact for information on Saint Croix Island IHS.

Your Fees at Work

The National Parks Pass is an important source of funds for Parks around the country. More than 80% of proceeds go directly into vital Park programs. For a perfect example of how the Parks Pass program has made a difference, you need look no further than the following Parks:

At **Yosemite National Park**, National Parks Pass revenues collected at the Park were used to survey spotted owls. The goal of the research is to find out how forest fires impact the lives of the spotted owl within the Park. In addition to helping Parks with research projects, Parks Pass funding can also help with improving visitor facilities. Using their National Parks Pass revenues, **Fort Laramie National Historic Site** was able to update their accessible ramps near five different historic structures to meet the required standards. At **Weir Farm National Historic Site**, Parks Pass funding helped convert the Park's Burlington Barn into a year-round facility for Park activities, as well as to add restrooms.

On top of visitor facilities, the Pass has also been used to improve Park staff operations. At **Zion National Park**, a new Emergency Operations Center was completed to help house the Parks' emergency vehicles and personnel.

Calling all Kids

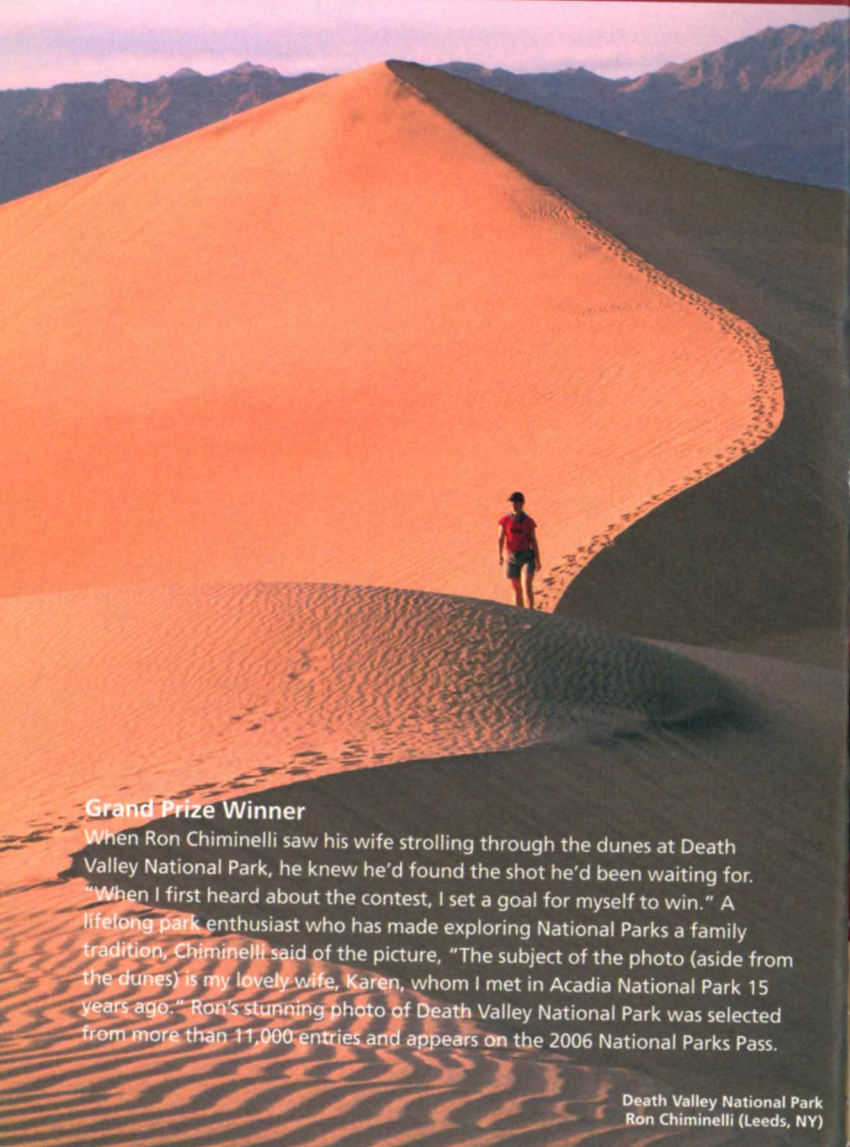
The story of America's heritage is preserved in our National Park System and thus, National Parks connect our children to America. Not only do they provide natural classrooms where kids can learn about nature and the environment, but they also contain invaluable reminders of our history and culture. There's a lot to be discovered in our Parks and this valuable program helps kids learn through the Parks themselves, online Junior Ranger websites, partnerships with schools and other youth organizations and much more! Through the Junior Ranger Program, kids complete Park-specific activities and, upon completion of the program, are presented with certificates and badges and are officially sworn in as that Park's newest Junior Rangers. There are over 297 National Parks that offer Junior Ranger programs, so be sure to keep that in mind when planning your next Park trip.

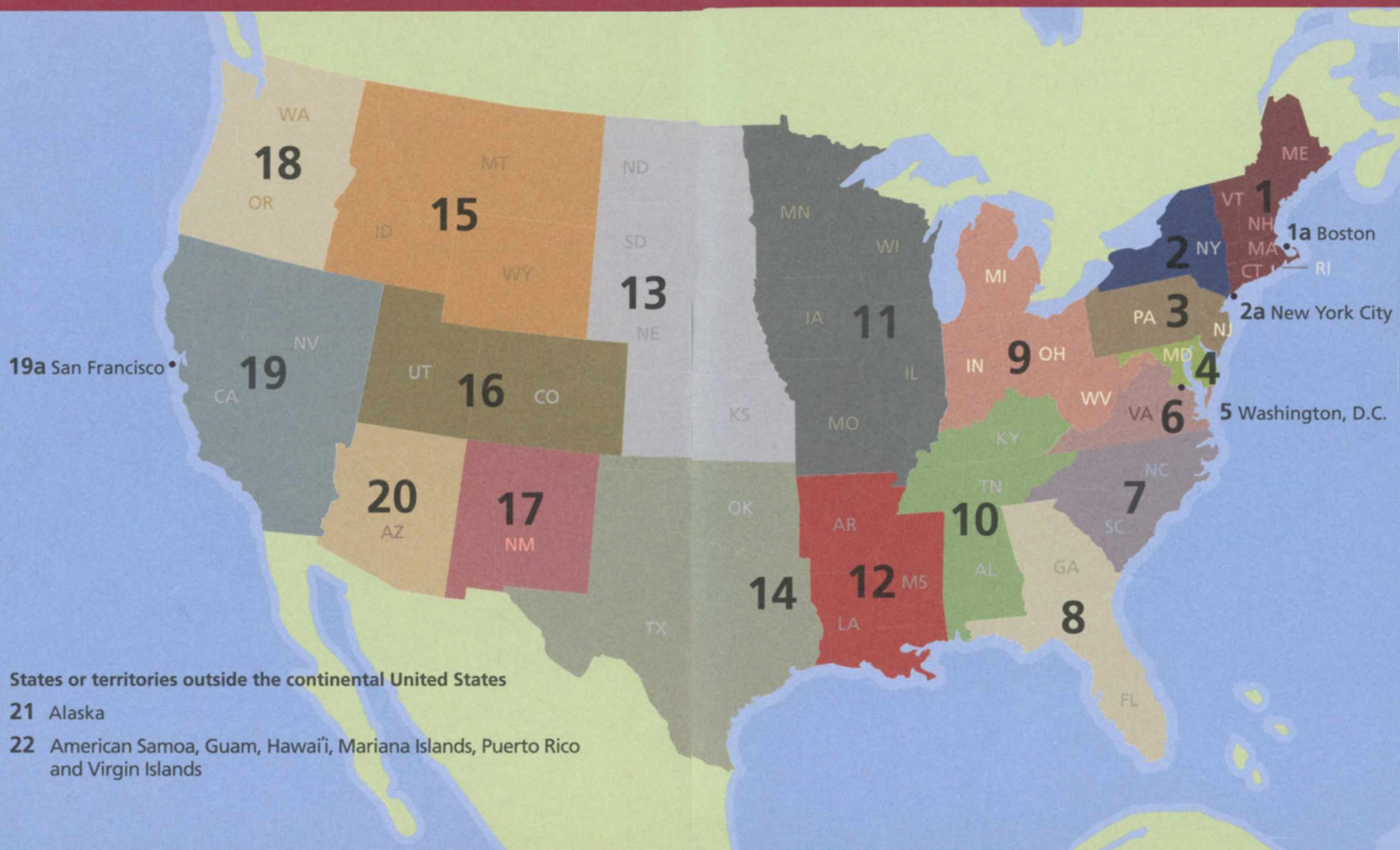

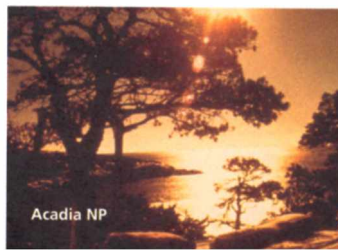

What will you see? For the history buff, Boston is the perfect location for a cultural and historical National Park experience. The **Boston African American National Historic Site**, located in Beacon Hill, includes 15 pre-Civil War structures that relate to the African American experience in Boston during the war. Visitors can experience all of these sites by taking a guided tour of the 1.6 mile **Black Heritage Trail**. Or consider the **Boston Harbor Islands National Recreation Area**. Take the 3 ½ hour **Boston Light Tour** and discover the revolution era lighthouse on Little Brewster Island. From the top of the Boston Light, you can enjoy the scenic view of the harbor and Boston's skyline. Or climb to the top of the tower at night to enjoy a truly dazzling view.

What will you see? Fire Island

National Seashore offers a unique escape for visitors searching for a pristine seaside vacation. Fire Island was established for the primary purpose of preserving seaside land in close proximity to an urban setting (1 hour east of New York City). Many backpackers and campers pass through every year as well as those interested in aquatic

recreation. The Park also provides educational opportunities like the Biennial Science Conference in which Park-related research programs are presented to the public and members of the scientific community in order to inform and generate helpful communication concerning the importance and relevance of ecological studies.

What will you see? Statue of Liberty National Monument and Ellis Island National Monument
both offer popular tours to visitors in New York City. Dedicated as a National Monument on October 25, 1924, the Statue of Liberty has long been a symbol of freedom and opportunity to American-born and immigrant residents alike. After

taking time to marvel at the icon known as "Lady Liberty," your next stop should be the museum on Ellis Island, dedicated to the history of American immigration. More than 12 million immigrants passed through this island for legal and medical inspections on their way to pursue a new life in the United States.

What will you see? Gettysburg National Military Park is the site of the largest Civil War battle and where President Lincoln delivered his famous "Gettysburg Address." Tour maps for auto tours are available at the visitor center as well

as guided battlefield tours hosted by Gettysburg experts. You can also spend some time at the Soldiers National Cemetery which was established by Union representatives shortly after the battle took place.

What will you see? Assateague Island National Seashore extends along the east coast of Maryland and Virginia. On Assateague, bands of wild horses freely roam among native plants and animals. All have adapted to a life of sand, salt and wind. It is a dynamic place, constantly reshaped by natural forces. Programs for public education include canoe trips and aquarium feedings where visitors have the opportunity to explore and

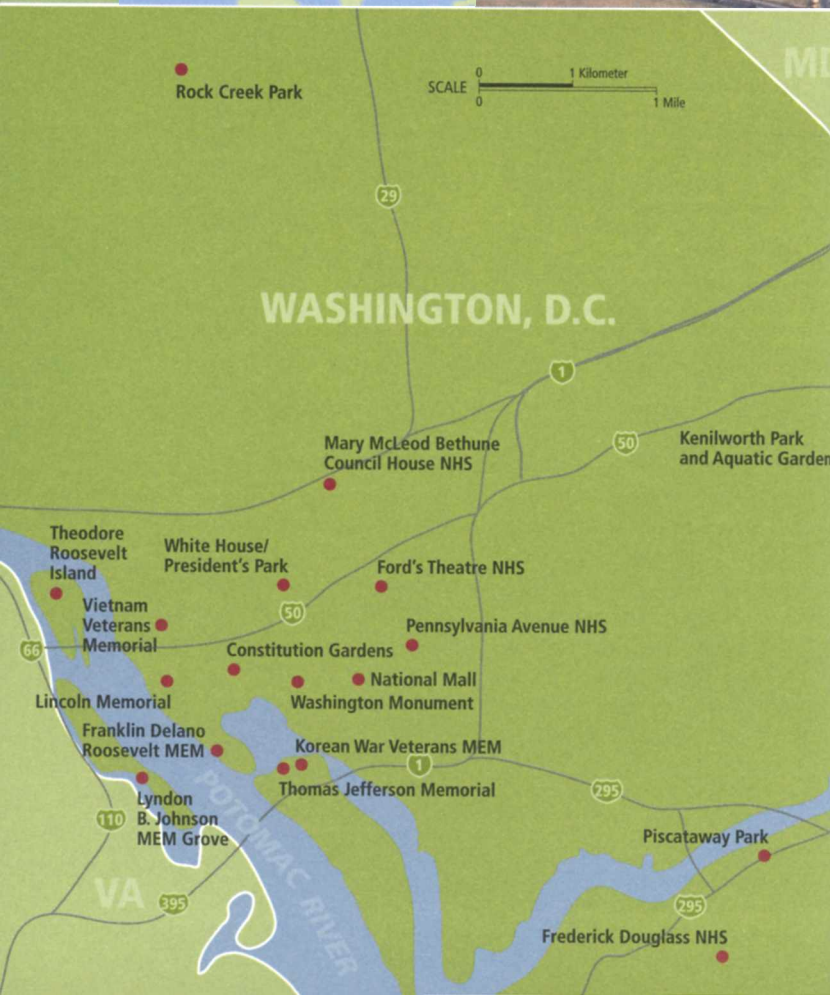

More than twenty-seven 19th century structures remain intact to immortalize General Robert E. Lee's surrender to General Ulysses S. Grant on April 9, 1865. The McLean House, which is where the actual surrender took place, was dismantled in 1893 and sent to Chicago with the intent of

sending it to Washington, D.C. to be reconstructed as a tourist attraction. Due to financial problems, the dismantled house never left the site. Soon after World War II, the house was meticulously reconstructed and the property was restored as closely as possible to its appearance in 1865. Today the McLean House is open year-round and furnished with a mix of original and reproduction furniture.

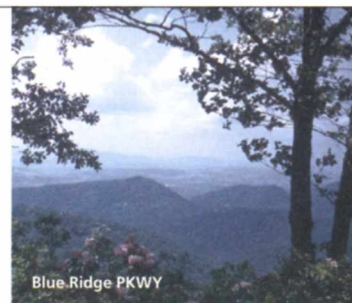

What will you see? The Lincoln Home National Historic Site is the centerpiece of a four-block historic neighborhood and has been restored to its 1860s appearance. Just across the border in St. Louis, Missouri stands the 630-foot tall Jefferson National Expansion Memorial Gateway Arch. With an

exterior made entirely of stainless steel, the Monument is a tribute to the spirit of the western pioneers. Just 15 minutes from the Arch is the Ulysses S. Grant National Historic Site where Grant and his wife, Julia Dent Grant wed, had three of their four children and lived for several years.

Notable National Park Happenings in 2006

Celebrating Ulysses S. Grant in St. Louis, MO—On April 27, 2006, join the United States Military Academy, the National Park Service and the Grant Monument Association in celebrating the birthday of President and General Ulysses S. Grant. The ceremony will take place at **General Grant National Memorial** and will include speeches, musical selections, military procession and ceremonies. Visit a Civil War encampment before and after the ceremony and learn about the U.S. Army life in the 19th century. Military medicine, life styles and technology will be demonstrated including artillery and small arms firings. Ceremony starts at 11:00 a.m. sharp. Encampment is open from 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. Free.

Discover Arches and Canyonlands National Parks with the Discovery Channel—Before you immerse yourself in the geological marvels of these Parks, be sure to stop at the visitor center and watch *Secrets of Red Rock*, a short film produced by the Discovery Channel in partnership with the National Park Foundation and the National Park Service.

The Salt Makers Return to Lewis and Clark National Historic Site—The Salt Makers Return is a unique interactive learning opportunity for the entire family at **Lewis and Clark National Historic Site**. For each of three weekends, February 17-19, July 14-16, and August 18-20, a historical interpretive program recreates the Lewis and Clark Expedition's salt making camp on the beach fifteen miles southwest of the Park. The salt water, stones (for building a fireplace), wood, game and freshwater made this an excellent location to set up the salt making operation. Visitors will have the opportunity to interact with historical interpreters of the Lewis and Clark Expedition who tend the fires and boil seawater to make salt. School groups are invited to participate in these programs by calling the Park and making a reservation. Both programs were developed in partnership with the Seaside Museum and Historical Society.

Honoring Orville and Wilbur Wright in North Carolina—There's a celebration for almost every season at **Wright Brothers National Memorial**. Join us on April 16, 2006 to celebrate Wilbur Wright's birthday. On August 19, we will celebrate National Aviation Day as well as Orville Wright's birthday. Finally, on December 17, we will have programs commemorating the anniversary of the first successful powered flight in a heavier-than-air machine. All festivities will feature special programs such as guest speakers, kite building, remarks by the Wright family, aircraft flyovers, book signings and flying demonstrations.

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
