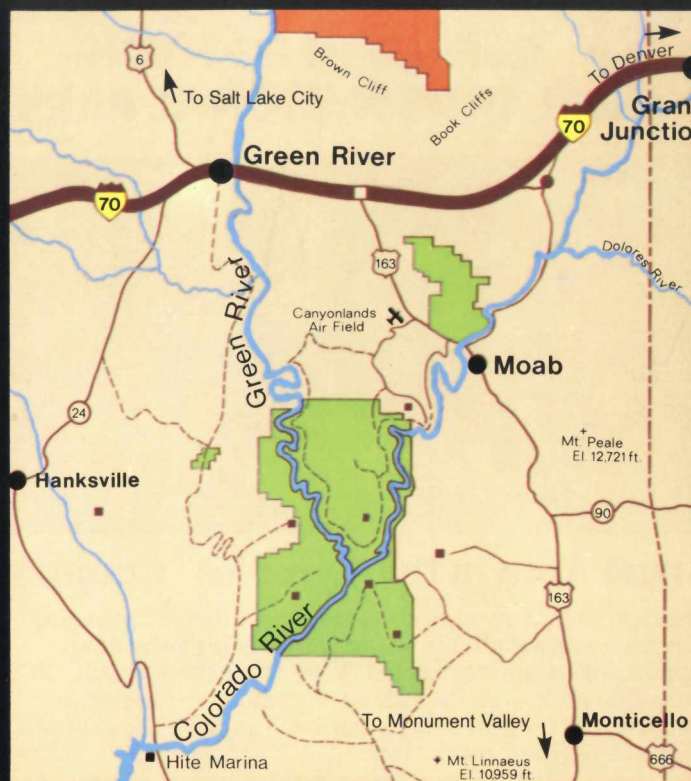

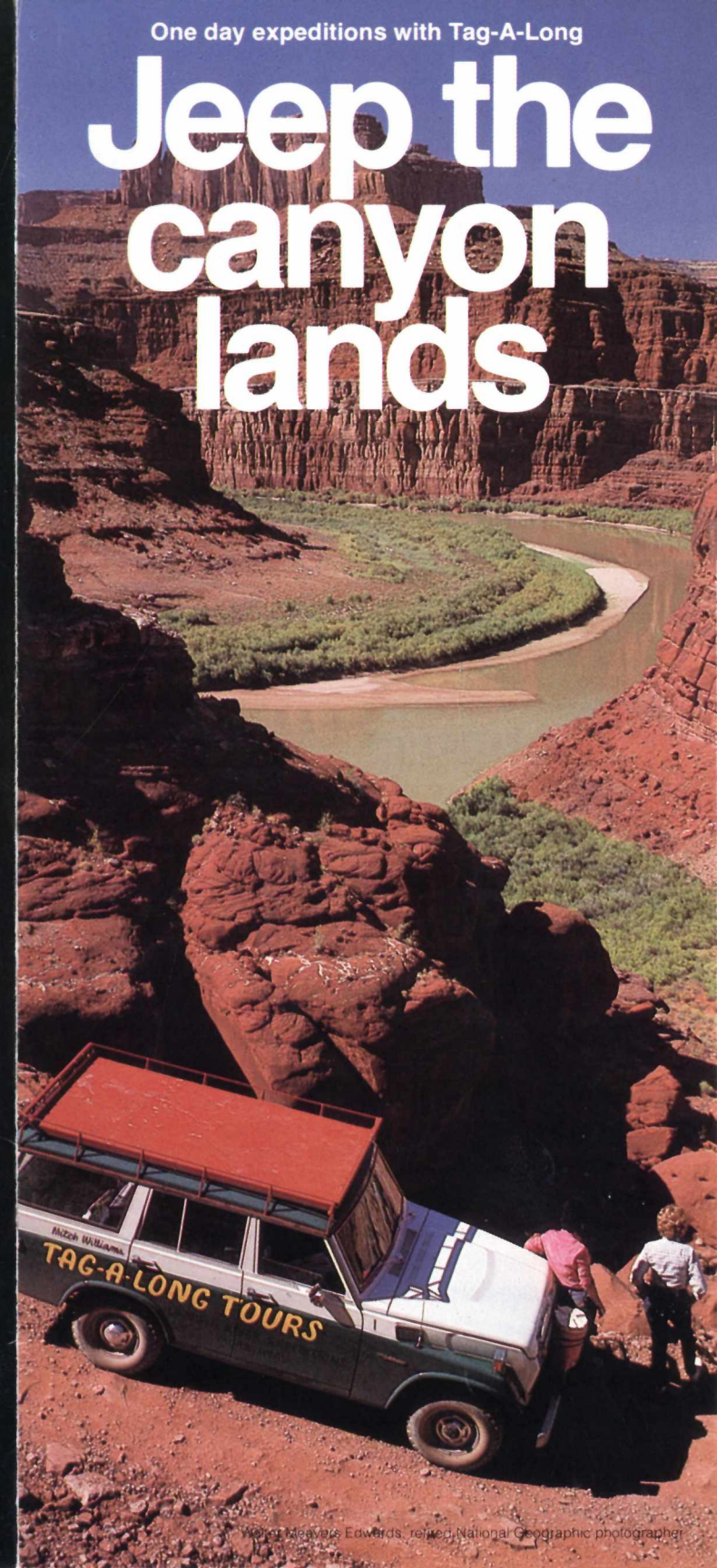

1 JEEPING IN CANYON- LANDS NATIONAL PARK



“The Island in the Sky!”

Canyonlands National Park is filled with wonderful treasures: Prehistoric Indian dwellings 1,000 years old, soaring rock arches seen only by a few, incredible panoramas overlooking 100's of miles and out of the way places as old and quiet as time itself. Unfortunately it is all but impossible to reach or find many of these sights with the family car.

Join Tag-A-Long's jeep expeditions — We'll open up the Canyonlands for you. (And if you haven't been jeeping, you have missed a great adventure.) On this expedition our sturdy 4-wheel drive vehicles bring you right up an old Indian trail cut out of the side of a soaring mesa to a region in Canyonlands National Park known as the “Island in the Sky.” (The “Island” is really a flat mountain top; a cool, lush area overlooking the thrilling beauty of this National Park.)

You will look down on the majestic Colorado River and the colorful Green River. In addition, you will be able to see over the “Maze” and the “Needles” areas of Canyonlands National Park — wonderfully scenic areas unreachable with your family car.

Since most groups are small, your experienced driver and guide often varies the exact route to pursue some of your particular interests such as photography, Indian ruins, hiking or geology. On every trip your guide stops at noon in a shady grove to fix you a tasty picnic.

Bring plenty of film and wear light clothing. You will be glad you took the time to explore the Island in the Sky.

Angel Arch in the “Needles” Country

Angel Arch is truly one of nature's most delightful sights: This arch soars high into the sky, seemingly providing support for an innocent angel. Very few have seen this incredible arch since its location is remote and access is restricted to 4-wheel drive vehicles. You have the chance to be one of those special few.

To reach the Angel, the trail winds up a dry creek bed at the bottom of one of this National Park's hundreds of narrow, twisting canyons. Along the route you'll see wonderful formations such as Six-Shooter Peak, Cathedral Rock and even an arch with the dubious name of Paul Bunyan's Potty.

Right in front of you is “Newspaper Rock,” a huge wall covered with inscriptions chiseled in by Indians dating back as much as 1,000 years. Your guide also points out Indian structures built right into the canyon walls; unfortunately, many unguided visitors pass right by them since they are well concealed. At noon, in the shade of a cottonwood grove, your guide prepares a tasty picnic just for your little group.

This is a full day expedition and is more rugged than our expedition to the Islands in the Sky. It requires frequent use of our 4-wheel drive capabilities. Yet, in one day, you reach right into the very heart of this wonderful National Park. We believe you will find it very satisfying indeed.

3 RAFT THE MIGHTY COLORADO!



You are poised just above the rapid. All of the gear is secure, the raft catches the current and gains speed. The nose dips down, then the whole raft bucks up and a splash washes over those in the front but does not stop the screams of delight and laughter. This is whitewater rafting and you're on America's best whitewater river, the Colorado!

To start the day, we bring you upstream from Moab, Utah to launch our rafts. At first the water is calm—time enough to become comfortable with the sturdy rafts and the skills of our competent boatmen. Soon you come to the first stretch of whitewater. Though the rapids along this section are classified as “moderate,” the thrills and splashes are simply great. It's an ideal introduction to the sport of whitewater rafting.

When Walt Disney Productions came to Moab to film whitewater rafting in America, they asked Tag-A-Long to guide them on this same section of the Colorado. (Look for this scene in their new 360 degree film at Disneyland.)

We pause during the day so you can explore the area or take a cool swim. There are several stretches of calm water, great for picture taking and just being lazy. At noon our guides prepare a picnic on a shady beach. We outfit you with water-tight containers for your camera, film and personal articles and fit you with a Coast Guard approved life vest. We'll pick you up right at your Moab motel or campground or you can meet us at our office.
