Remnants of an older volcano and dike exposed after the great eruption and collapse of Mt. Mazama 6850 years ago.



Enjoy the Tour

Enjoy a 1¾-hour narrated tour around Crater Lake, including a 5-minute stop at Wizard Island.

BOAT TOURS

ACCESS: Crater Lake Boat Tours begin at Cleetwood Cove, 13 miles from Rim Village along Rim Drive. From the trailhead across from the parking lot, follow a 1.1 mile trail as it descends 700 feet to the Cleetwood Boat Landing. Allow 1 hour for trail from Rim Village. The return uphill is strenuous. Restrooms only at Cleetwood Cove. Tickets sold only at Cleetwood Cove.

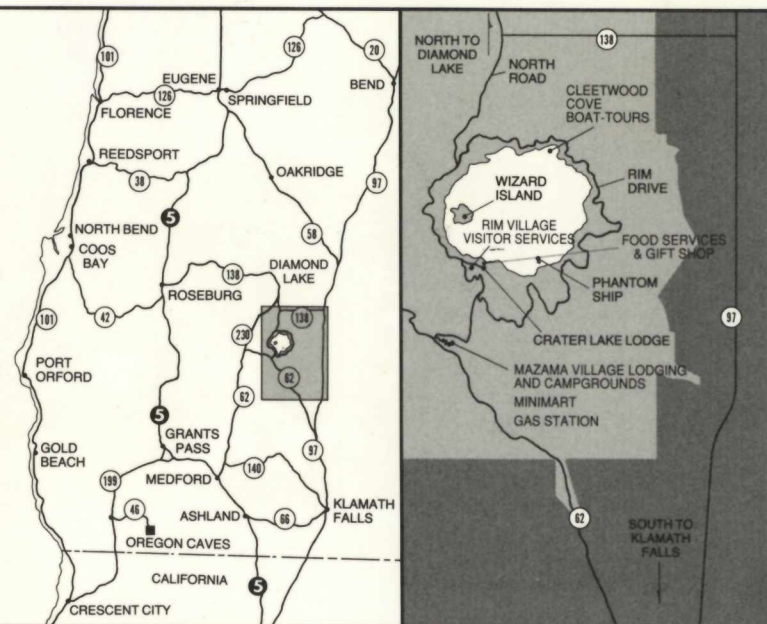
TOUR BOATS: Sturdy, sixty passenger launches leave on a regular schedule (10 am-4 pm) from late June through early September accompanied by park ranger.

ESSENTIALS: Be prepared! Wear Comfortable clothing and sturdy shoes. Bring a hat, water, sunglasses, sunscreen. Bring protective clothing to be prepared for sudden weather changes.

RESERVATIONS: Passengers accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Large groups should contact the boat tour manager two weeks in advance to arrange additional needed capacity.

SERVICES: Crater Lake offers overnight lodging, groceries, and gasoline at Mazama Village, adjacent to the Mazama Campground. Food services, gifts and souvenirs are available at Rim Village.

OTHER ACTIVITIES: Crater Lake National Park has many day hikes to scenic overlooks. Stop at Visitor Center for more information on Crater Lake and for schedules on daily interpretive programs.
