Six Hour Ride

A scenic ride across the McDonald Creek to the abandoned fire lookout. From the vantage point at the lookout, you may see the beautiful McDonald Valley and other points in the Park and Flathead National Forest.

Two Hour Rides

A nice gentle ride along McDonald Creek, past the eagle observatory and the oxbow in McDonald Creek. Elk and other wild animals are often seen in the meadows and the lodgepole forest.

One hour rides

A guided gentle ride through the meadow and lodgepole pine. Viewing the Middle Fork of the Flathead River.

All Day Rides

Sperry Chalet - An easy ride in itself to a beautiful chalet built of natural rock in a high alpine setting with a spectacular view. You may arrange to stay there overnight and hike to further points if you desire.

Trout Lake or Arrow Lake - Ride through mature cedar and hemlock forest over Howe Ridge to the riparian habitat of Camas Creek drainage. Several small lakes are nestled in this valley between Mount Stanton and Rogers Peak. Spectacular views of Rogers Peak across Trout Lake.

Three Hour Rides

Paradise Valley - After crossing the rustic bridge on McDonald Creek you enter the beautiful Paradise Valley with its magnificent flowers and towering trees. Wildlife such as moose, bear and deer are often seen on this trail.

Two Hour Rides

McDonald Falls - (for novices) An easy scenic ride to beautiful McDonald Falls, leaving the horse corral every two hours.

One Hour Rides

A ride through forest dotted with ferns and wildflowers. An easy ride for beginners. These rides are available throughout the day, when horses and guides are available.

All Day Rides

Poia Lake - A scenic ride over Swiftcurrent Ridge, into the Kennedy Creek drainage, as far as Poia Lake.

Granite Park Chalet - A ride over Swiftcurrent Pass, one of the most scenic in the Park to a chalet built of rock in a high alpine setting. There should be numerous mountain goats seen on this trip. We suggest an overnight stay at the Chalet if you desire. Trip may be cancelled at the corral managers discretion if inclement weather conditions exist.

Cracker Lake - Below Siyeh Glacier - A ride along Lake Sherburne to Canyon Creek then climbing switchbacks along the alpine valley to Cracker Lake. Visit the abandoned copper mine.

Three Hour Rides

Grinnell Lake - Nestled in a glacier cirque at the foot of a mountain thousands of feet beneath Grinnell Glacier. A spectacular and easy trip for anyone who has never ridden before.

Two Hour Rides

Josephine Lake - A scenic ride along the Piegan Trail looking down on Josephine Lake then a gentle descent to the lower Josephine Lake trail through alpine forest and meadows along the lake.

Cracker Flats - A ride along Lake Sherburne and the Governors Pond to Cracker Flats where the town of Alton once stood at the turn of the century.

One Hour Rides

Along the lower Josephine Lake trail and the upper Piegan Trail. An easy ride for the beginner, young child, or senior citizen. These rides are available throughout the day, when horses and guides are available.
