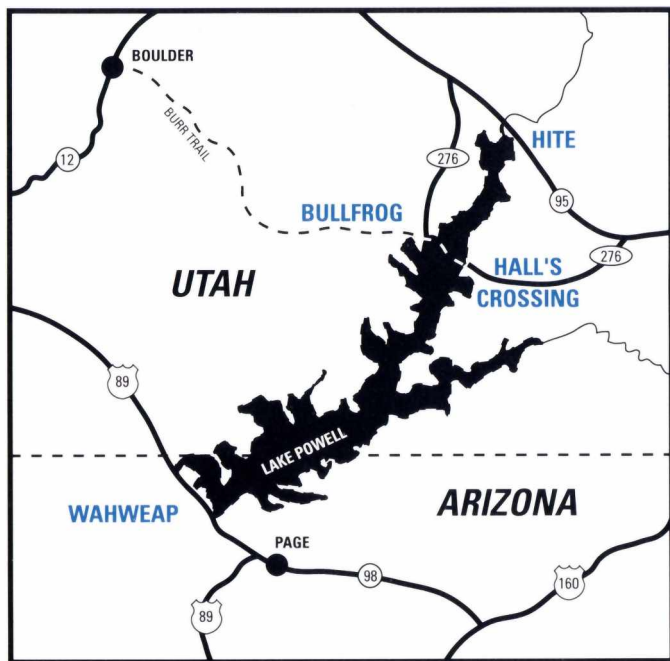


The John Atlantic Burr

John Atlantic Burr is 100 feet long and 42 feet wide. Weighing 245 tons, it displaces 100 tons of water. Twin 2,500 gallon tanks supply diesel fuel to two 8V-71 Detroit engines. Vehicle capacity is eight cars and two buses. Maximum passenger capacity is 150. Design is by Alexander Love and Co., Victoria, British Columbia, and construction is by Mark Steel, Salt Lake City, Utah. The ferry is named after John Atlantic Burr, a pioneer Utah rancher born in 1846 aboard a ship somewhere in the Atlantic Ocean. It has facilitated visitation by tour bus operators attracted by the nation's greatest concentration of national parks and monuments. Hall's Crossing/Bullfrog is almost the exact center of this geographic area known as the "Grand Circle." Maximum road miles saved by ferry operation: 130.



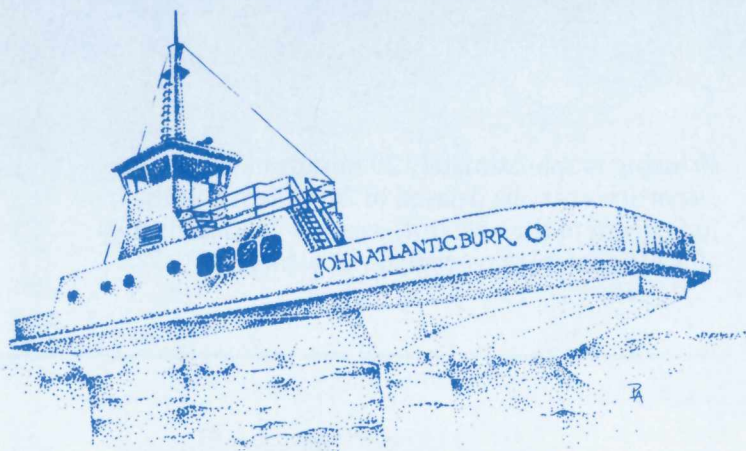
A Cooperative Venture
