The Canyon King is available year 'round for charter groups of 20 or more people. With two deck levels and a capacity of 150 guests, the steam-toting paddlewheeler is ideal for dancing, dining and cocktail cruises. Reservations are suggested.

GROUP CHARTERS (B, HC, H)

In addition to Rainbow Bridge tours (minimum six passengers), Bullfrog offers the following tours to groups of 20 or more: Bullfrog and Hall's Crossing Bays (one hour); Defiance House Indian Ruins (two and one-half hours); Escalante River (five hours or more). Call Group Reservations at 1-800-341-8934 for rates and policies.

Individuals or small groups can charter guided boat tours from Bullfrog, Hall's Crossing or Hite marinas any time of the year at \$45 per hour, \$270 per day (five passenger maximum) with advance reservations.

PACKAGE ADVENTURES

RAINBOW EXPLORER (W, B)

Two nights lodging plus all-day tour to Rainbow Bridge, including lunch. This guided cruise provides leisurely inspection of Lake Powell's famous national monument plus time to enter and photograph several of the lake's larger canyons. Tour boats depart 9 a.m. daily.

RAINBOW EXPLORER—HALF-DAY (W)

Two nights lodging and half-day guided tour to Rainbow Bridge. Tours leave 7:00 a.m. and 1 p.m. in season, 11:00 a.m. other times.

COLORADO COMBO (W)

Three nights lodging. All-day cruise to Rainbow Bridge, with lunch. All-day Colorado River float from Glen Canyon Dam to Lee's Ferry, with lunch; available May through September and other times by special arrangements (five-passenger minimum). Tours depart 9 a.m.—boat tour from Wahweap and float tour from 50 South Lake Powell Blvd., Page.

BOAT TOUR AND PACKAGE POLICIES

FARES:

All boat tours require five fares, except Rainbow Bridge and Canyon King trips, which require six. Children's fares: under age 12; two and under—free. Tour packages include taxes.

RESERVATIONS/CANCELLATIONS:

To reserve a boat tour or package tour, one half of the total cost is required. This deposit is transferable or refundable if cancellation is received 24 hours in advance. Off-season tour departure times subject to daily cancellation/consolidation. Reservations recommended year 'round.

SPECIAL NOTES:

Boats carrying more than six fares equipped with TOILET FACILITIES. NO PETS permitted on tour boats.

DEL WEBB'S WILDERNESS RIVER ADVENTURES

FISHING SERVICES (Wahweap only)

GUIDE ONLY—\$16 per hour (\$128 per day).

GUIDE/CHARTER—Includes tackle (lures, but not live bait), lunch, beverages (non-alcoholic), fuel and insurance. 1 or 2 people—\$175 per day. 1-4 people—\$285 per day. Tax not included.

GROUP CHARTER—\$47.50 per hour (\$285 per day).

Advance reservations required. Central Reservations handles only full-day reservations; call marinas to book guide and/or charter on less than full-day basis. Day is 8 hours.

YOU'LL LIKE THE WEATHER

Summer temperatures rarely reach 100, and winters are warmed by abundant Colorado plateau sunshine (78% possible sunshine year 'round). Snow is rare. Springs and falls are delightful, and year 'round low humidity increases the comfort factor. If gusty winds occur, boaters are advised to seek shelter in a canyon or cove.

BOAT RENTALS

BOAT RENTAL CONDITIONS

▲ REQUIRED DEPOSITS are confirming/damage deposits, do not apply toward rental fee and are due in our office 5-10 days after reservation is made or reservation will be cancelled. Deposit is refundable when boat is returned on time, in same condition checked out.

▲ FULL HOUSEBOAT payment is required 30 days prior to boarding. Full rental fee (minus deposit) will be retained unless reservation cancellation is received, IN WRITING, 15 days prior to boarding. (ALSO SEE CANCELLATION POLICY).

▲ ACCEPTABLE PRE-PAID RENTAL and/or deposit payment is with cash, check, VISA or MasterCard. Damage deposits will be refunded in same method paid.

▲ HOUSEBOATS may not be loaded until contract is signed and check-out completed.

▲ NO REBATES for late arrival or early returns.

▲ FUEL tanks are filled before check-out. Refueling is renter's responsibility.

▲ CHARGES will be made for damaged boats, props and other lost/damaged items.

▲ RENTALS limited to adults age 18 and older.

▲ ALL HOUSEBOATS are rented by the NIGHT.

▲ HOUSEBOAT CHECK-OUT is between 2 and 5 p.m. For scheduling, check with marina office upon arrival. Check-in no later than 9:00 a.m. morning of last day.

▲ GENERAL FEATURES—Railed walkways, range and oven, refrigerator, ice chest, cabin heater, 12-volt light system, shower, toilet, bunk beds, drapes and charcoal or gas grill. All-weather cabin, two pontoon floats, two outboard engines.

▲ WATER available at all marinas. 40 gallons drinking water on board. Non-drinking supply for showers, washing dishes, etc., is unlimited.

▲ TOILETS—Boats are equipped with a 120-gallon sewage holding tank. Each marina has pumpout facilities, if needed.

▲ SUPPLIES INCLUDE—Portable or gas grill, silverware, pots, pans, plates, cups, trash bags and liners, bucket, mop, dust pan and broom, pillows and toilet tissue.

▲ WHAT TO BRING—Bedding, linens and towels. We suggest a shovel and any on-shore camping equipment desired. You may want to bring a compass, binoculars, a battery-operated tape deck and flashlight.

▲ NO ELECTRICAL outlets or generators on board.

▲ OPERATION—Operator is checked out on all procedures at marina. No special skills needed, only respect for size of craft, its engines and basic boating rules and courtesy.

▲ MAPS—A necessity to first-time visitors. Available through the reservations office and at all marina stores and boat rental offices.

▲ WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OF RUNNING TIME DUE TO EQUIPMENT FAILURE, WEATHER, ILLNESS, ACCIDENTS OR CHANGES IN PLANS.

SPECIAL SMALL BOAT INFORMATION

▲ RENTAL DAY is figured from marina opening of 1 calendar day to 1 hour before closing of same calendar day.

▲ TAGALONGS will have the same check-out and check-in times as apply to houseboats. 10% discount applied to powerboat's regular daily rate when rented with houseboat.

CANCELLATION POLICY

A service fee of \$50.00 will be charged on all houseboat cancellations prior to 30 days of boarding. Full houseboat deposit is transferable if notice is received 30 days prior to boarding. The balance of houseboat deposits are refundable to reservation holder or transferable, ONLY when WRITTEN notice is received 30 days prior to boarding. Full rental fee will be retained unless cancellation is received, IN WRITING, 15 days prior to boarding. Other boats require 10 days WRITTEN notice for full refund.

SOME STANDARD POLICIES

We are authorized to serve the public by the National Park Service, the U.S. Coast Guard and Interstate Commerce Commission. We reserve the right to change equipment or cancel any trip at any time for any reason (in our best judgement concerning weather, safety, etc.). If a trip is cancelled and alternate arrangements are not satisfactory, fares or deposits will be refunded. We also reserve the right to refuse use of equipment, facilities, etc., if the renter or customer in our judgement is ill or otherwise in a situation which might affect his own or the safety of others. We also reserve the right to call in rented boats improperly or unsafely handled.

BOAT SAFETY FEATURES

All boats contain safety equipment such as fire extinguishers, life preservers, anchor (houseboats only), sound device, paddle (powerboats) and night light as required by the Coast Guard.

BOATS & LICENSED PILOTS

Our boats are inspected by the Park Service under specifications of the Coast Guard, which licenses our pilots. Our guides are also experienced and licensed.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Optional waiver of liability, limiting liability to \$250 in event boat is damaged, may be purchased for houseboats (\$11/night) and powerboat rentals (\$5-6/day or night).

Houseboat reservations for 1988 (subject to price increases) may be made beginning January 2, 1987. Early reservations, especially for the Summer season, are strongly encouraged.
