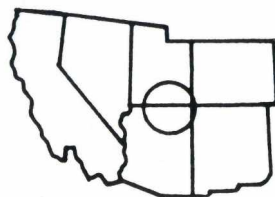

Lake Powell is the center of the Grand Circle, which includes Monument Valley, plus Grand Canyon, Bryce Canyon, Mesa Verde and Zion national parks.

BOAT RENTALS.

If you haven't seen Lake Powell from the sun-

drenched decks of a houseboat, then you haven't seen Lake Powell. Enjoy water sports, find a private cove, catch some rays on a secluded sandy beach, or watch a dramatic canyon sunset. Powerboats are also available—perfect for exploring the lake's endless supply of winding inlets. For boating, there's simply no finer lake in the world.

BOAT RENTAL CONDITIONS.

Required deposits are confirming/damage deposits. They do not apply towards rental fee and are due in our office within 14 days after reservation is made, or reservation will be cancelled. Deposit is refundable when boat is returned on time, in same condition checked out.

Full houseboat payment is required 30 days prior to boarding. Full rental fee (minus deposit) will be retained unless reservation cancellation is received, in writing, 30 days prior to boarding. (Also see cancellation policy.)

Acceptable rental and/or deposit payment is with cash, check, VISA or MasterCard. Damage deposits will be refunded in same method paid. Personal checks are not acceptable within 30 days of arrival.

Houseboats may not be loaded until contract is signed and check-out completed.

No rebates for late arrivals or early returns.

Fuel tanks are filled before check-out. Refueling is renter's responsibility.

Charges will be made for damaged boats, props and other lost/damaged items. (See Waiver of Liability.)

Rentals limited to adults age 18 and older.

All houseboats are rented by the night.

Houseboat check-out is between 2 and 5 p.m. For scheduling, check with boat rental office upon arrival. Check-in no later than 9 a.m. morning of last day.

GENERAL FEATURES.

Railed walkways, range and oven, refrigerator, ice chest, cabin heater, 12-volt light system, shower, toilet,

bunk beds, drapes and gas grill. All-weather cabin, 2 pontoon floats, 2 out-board engines.

Water available at all marinas. 40 gallons drinking water on board. Non-drinking supply for showers, washing dishes, etc. is unlimited.

TOILETS.

Boats are equipped with a 120-gallon sewage holding tank. Each marina has pump-out facilities, if needed.

SUPPLIES INCLUDE:

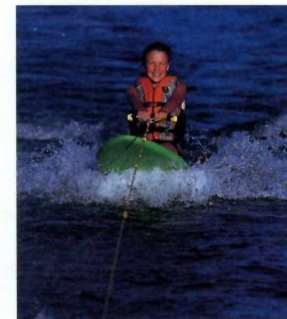
Gas grill, silverware, pots, pans, plates, cups, trash bags and liners, bucket, mop, dust pan and broom, camp pillows and toilet tissue.

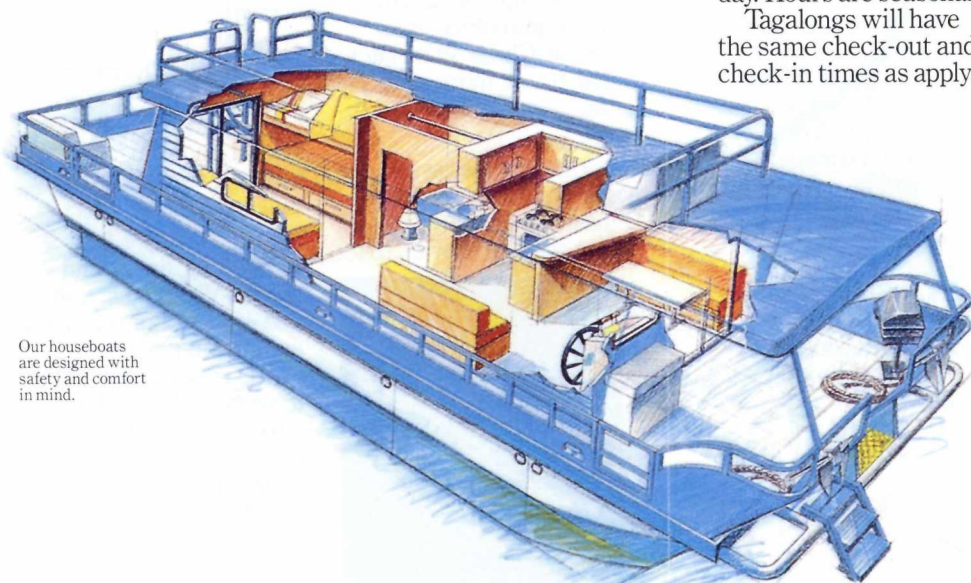
OPERATION.

Rental day begins when marina opens and ends one hour before closing of same day. Hours are seasonal.

houseboats. 10% discount applied to powerboat's regular daily rate when rented with houseboat.

CANCELLATION POLICY.

There is a \$75 service charge for each houseboat cancellation or change. The remaining deposit will be refunded or transferred ONLY if notice is received in our office 45 days prior to reserved day. **ALL PAYMENTS WILL BE FORFEITED IF CANCELLATION OR CHANGES ARE MADE TO A RESERVATION LESS THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO BOARDING.** Small boat rentals require a 10-day notice of cancellation for full refund.

BOAT SAFETY FEATURES.

All boats contain safety equipment such as fire extinguishers, life preservers, anchor (houseboats only), sound device, paddle (powerboats) and night light as required by the Coast Guard.

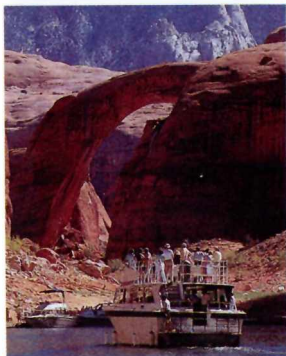

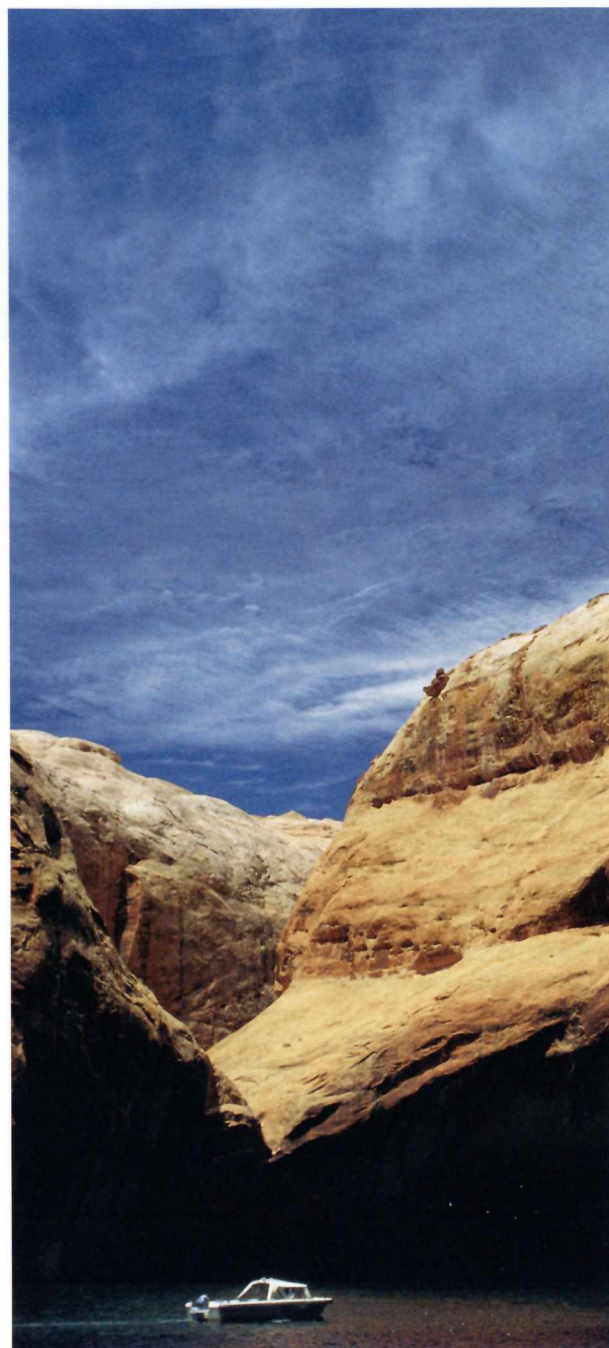

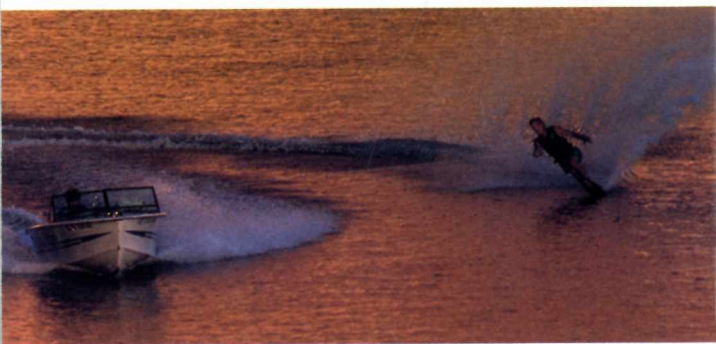
