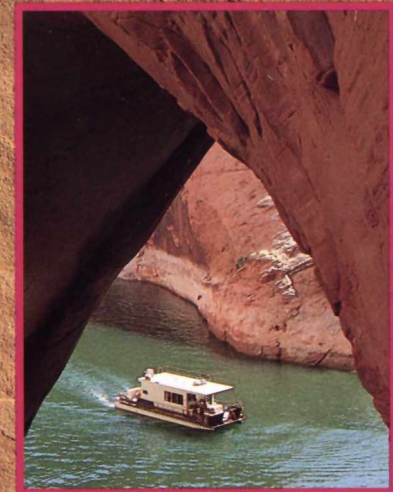

Additional Information, Including Terms and Conditions

Boat Tours

Check-in—Please check with the Boat Tours desk at least 30 minutes prior to departure.

Fares—Children's fares are for under age 12; children age 2 and under are free.

Tour Boat Facilities—Carrying 6 or more passengers are equipped with toilet facilities.

Pets—Sorry, no pets are permitted on tour boats.

Reservations/Cancellations—To reserve a boat tour, a guaranty or full payment is required. This full payment is transferable or refundable if notice of cancellation is received 24 hours in advance of departure. Off-season tour departure times are subject to daily cancellation/consolidation. Advance reservations are recommended year-round.

Houseboats

Deposits—Your houseboat deposit is a confirmation of your reservation, as well as a damage deposit. The deposit does not apply toward the rental fee and is due in our office within 14 days after making your reservation (otherwise the reservation will be automatically cancelled). Damage deposits will be refunded in the same method of payment when boat is returned on time and in the same condition as it was checked out.

Payment—Full houseboat payment is required 45 days prior to boarding. Full rental fee (minus your deposit) will be retained unless reservation cancellation is received in writing, 30 days prior to boarding. Acceptable rental and/or deposit payment is with cash, check, VISA or MasterCard.

Please no personal checks within 30 days of arrival.

Check-in/Check-out—Renter must be at least 18 years old. All houseboats are rented by the day. Houseboat check-out is 8 a.m. Check-in is 2 p.m. on the last day of contract. No rebates will be issued for late arrivals or early returns. Houseboats may not be loaded until contract is signed and check-out is completed. (Note: Check-out with instructor takes approximately 30 minutes to one hour.)

Damages—Charges will be made for damaged boats, props and other lost/damaged items (see Waiver of Liability).

Damage Deposit Refund Policy—Service charges based on receipt of written notice of cancellation:
91-120 days prior to arrival—\$75
46-90 days prior to arrival—\$150
Less than 45 days prior to arrival—\$350

Fuel—Tanks are filled before check-out. Refueling is renter's responsibility.

Waiver of Liability—An optional waiver of liability, limiting your liability responsibility to \$250 in the event a boat is damaged, may be purchased for an additional \$13.75 per day. Applicable taxes not included.

Limit of Responsibility—We are not responsible for loss of running time due to equipment failure, weather, illness, accidents or changes in plans.

No Houseboats Available?—If no houseboats are available on your first choice of vacation dates, we suggest alternate plans:
1) Ask to be put on our waiting list.
2) Consider another date, or if necessary, another season of the year.
3) Stay in our lodge, motel or housekeeping units and rent a powerboat.
4) See the lake by tour boat.
5) Rent a powerboat and camp on sandy beaches.

Small Boat

Rental Day—Rental day begins when the marina opens, and ends one hour before the marina is scheduled to close that same day. Marina operating hours vary from season to season.

Tagalongs—Check-out and check-in times for tagalongs are the same for those described under "Houseboats".

Liability Waiver—Optional waiver of liability, limiting your liability responsibility to \$250 in the event a boat is damaged, may be purchased for an additional \$6.00 for our 16' skiff, \$7.25 for our powerboats, and \$9.50 for our patio boat. Applicable taxes not included.

Standard Policies

We are authorized to serve the public by the National Park Service, the U.S. Coast Guard and Interstate Commerce Commission. We reserve the right to change equipment or cancel at any time for any reason (in our best judgement concerning weather, safety, etc.). If a trip is cancelled and alternate arrangements are not satisfactory, fares or deposits will be refunded. We also reserve the right to refuse use of equipment, facilities, etc., if the renter or customer in our judgement is ill or otherwise in a situation which might affect his own safety, or the safety of others. We also reserve the right to call in rented boats improperly or unsafely handled.

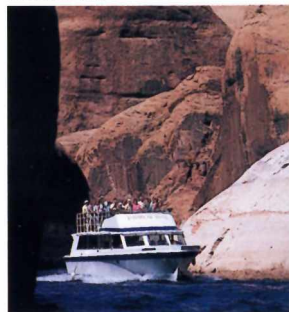

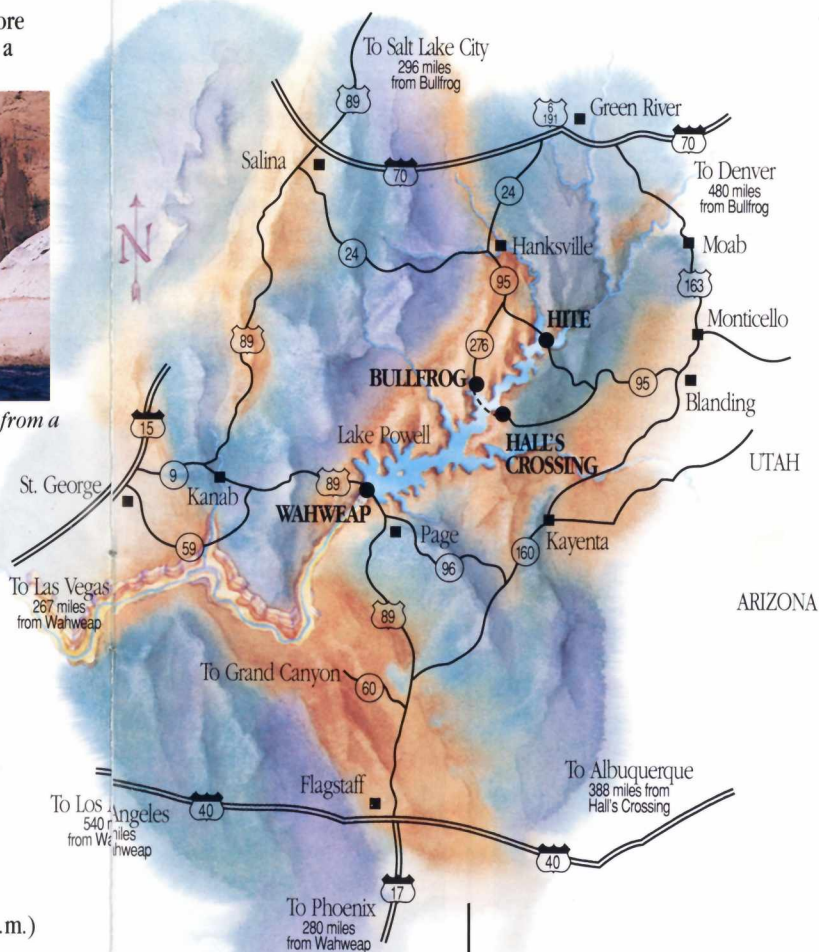

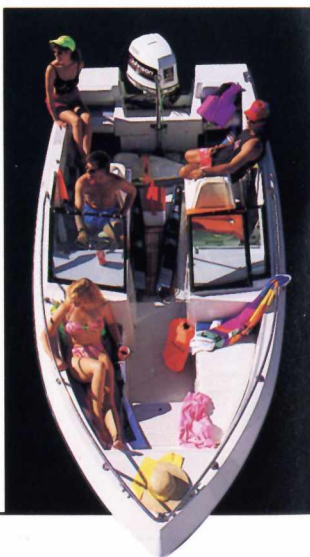
18' Runabout

Multi-purpose boat features sturdy fiberglass hull with 120 horsepower motor. Easily pulls all our water toys. Includes storage for camping gear or other necessities beneath bow. High gunwales make this beauty ideal for family fishing or cutting through rough water. Seats six comfortably. One-half canopy. Tows well behind a houseboat.



19' Runabout

Our largest, most powerful (150 h.p.) all-purpose boat. Excellent for skiing and pulling other water toys as well as family camping and fishing. Sturdy fiberglass hull. Open bow. Spacious storage areas. Half-canopy. Seats nine passengers.



24' Patio Boat

This aluminum pontoon boat is ideal for leisurely cruising the lake during the day, camping, or just relaxing with family and friends. Includes lots of storage space, and full, fixed canopy. Beaches nicely, and it's easy to get on and off. Not designed for rough water traveling, or towing water toys. Includes canopy.



'Nonnezoshi' — A Favorite Destination

Rainbow Bridge National Monument is a favorite destination of boaters. With a span of 275 feet, it gracefully arches to a height of 290 feet and a top width of up to 42 feet. Navajo Indians call it Nonnezoshi, "rainbow of stone." This soaring ribbon of sandstone, the world's largest natural bridge, is considered a sacred place by the Navajos. It nestles among canyons carved by streams en route to the Colorado River from Navajo Mountain's north flank.

16' Skiff

This smaller boat also makes a great houseboat tagalong. A favorite for short trips and day use. Wooden seats. Aluminum V-hull. Motor steers by hand from back seat. Well suited to cove and shoreline fishing.

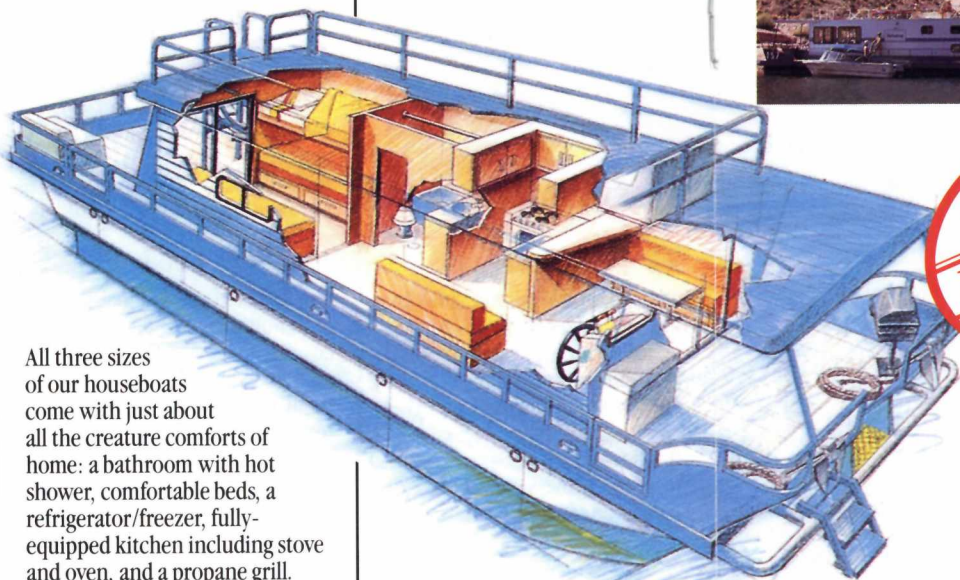


HOUSEBOATS

There's simply no better way to enjoy all that Lake Powell has to offer than from behind the wheel of one of our rental houseboats.

With 1,960 miles of lake shoreline awaiting you, you'll never run out of new places to see, fish, explore and play in.

Piloting a houseboat is as easy as driving a car. And if you follow a map and National Park Service buoys, navigating is a cinch.



All three sizes of our houseboats come with just about all the creature comforts of home: a bathroom with hot shower, comfortable beds, a refrigerator/freezer, fully-equipped kitchen including stove and oven, and a propane grill.

If you've always wanted to be captain of your own ship, now is the perfect opportunity to do so, and this is the perfect lake.

A Fishing Bonanza—Lake Powell, long known for its largemouth bass and crappie fishing, now includes striped and small-mouth bass, plus walleye. See if you can top one of these:

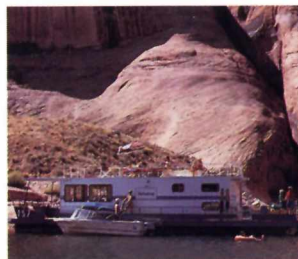

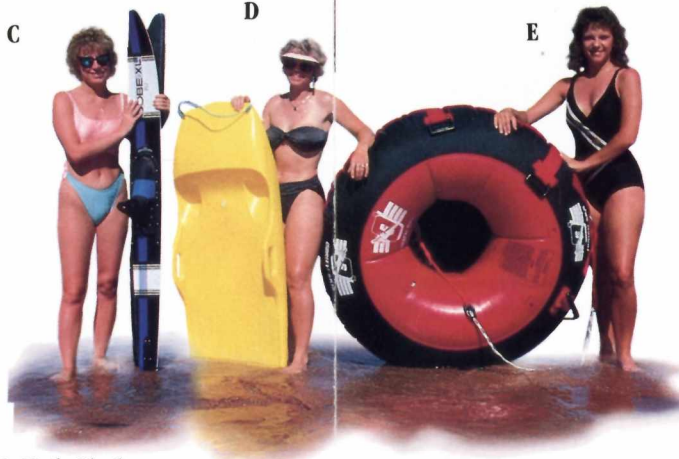

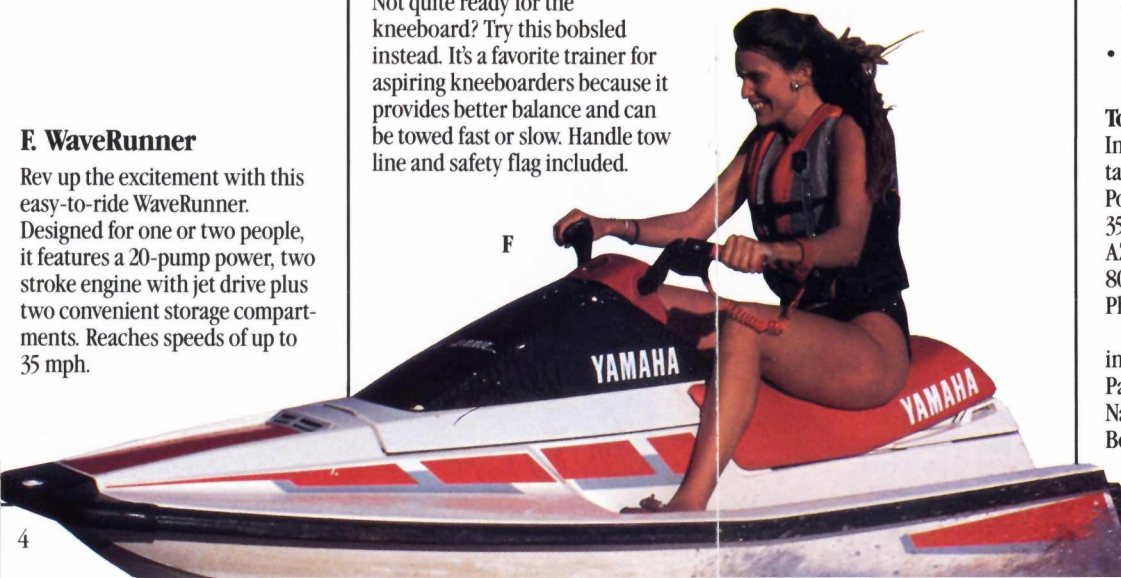
D. Bob Sled

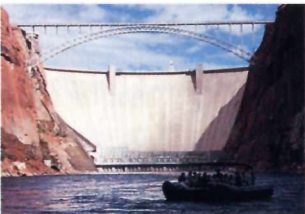
FLOAT TRIPS & WHITE-WATER RAFTING

Float Trips

For an unforgettable experience, let us take you on a gentle raft float down the Colorado River.

Skilled crews will guide you through the gently rippling rapids in comfortable, flexible, and safe neoprene rafts.

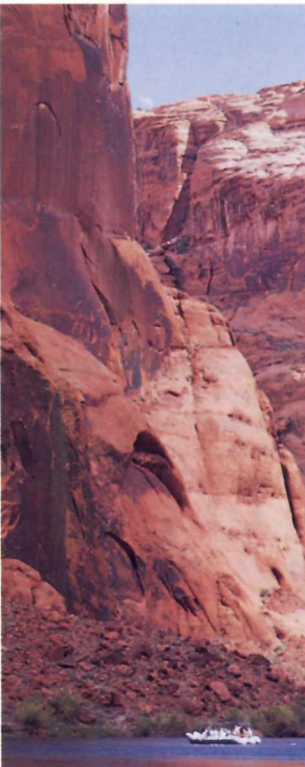
It's a 15-mile adventure into the last undammed section of the Colorado River that John Wesley Powell named Glen Canyon. You'll see soaring sandstone cliffs rising 2,400 feet above river level. And you'll get a close-up look at ancient Indian petroglyphs. The trip concludes downstream at historic Lees Ferry with its early settlers' cabins—a must for photographers.

You'll Love The Weather—

Summer temperatures sometimes exceed 100 degrees, and winters are warmed by abundant Colorado plateau sunshine. Snow is rare. Spring and fall are delightful. Year-round low humidity increases the comfort factor. Lake Powell averages 78% possible sunshine year-round.

Private Aircraft Facilities—

WAHWEAP (Page Airport): 5,000-foot surfaced, lighted runway with fueling facilities. Call Wahweap for transportation and reservation service. Airport rental cars available. BULLFROG: 3,500-foot surfaced runway with tie-downs. HALL'S CROSSING: 3,685-foot firmly-graveled strip with tie downs. (When flying into Bullfrog or Hall's Crossing, we'll meet your plane with advanced notice via Unicom 122.8.)

Boat Docking and Storage—

Short-term slip rentals, available at all road-accessible marinas, may be booked through Central Reservations when you make your vacation

plans. (Maximum boat size: 10' x 30'.) Contact marina concerning long-term slip, buoy or dry storage needs.

Boat Service—Our authorized OMC, Mercury and Volvo mechanics can service most boats and motors. We also stock a large selection of parts.

Auto Services—Each resort/marina includes an auto service station. Hite, with limited services, is the only marina that does not offer diesel fuel.

Bullfrog/Hall's Crossing Ferry—A 100-foot ferry provides daily runs between these two mid-lake marinas. It accommodates passengers, vehicles and trailers of all sizes.

Avoid Crowds/Save Money—There are many reasons to visit Lake Powell other than the summer months such as: uncrowded conditions, moderate temperatures, great fishing, and lower boat rental and lodging rates. During certain times, houseboats may be rented for as few as two nights or even one night.

Calendar of Events—There are special events taking place at Lake Powell every month. To make sure you don't miss your favorite, we'll be happy to send you a list of our upcoming attractions. Call or write today.

Travel Agent Policies—We pay 10% commission to authorized travel agents on all services. We suggest agents deduct this commission and remit net payment to Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas/ARA Leisure Services.

Airline Service—Page, Arizona is served daily by SkyWest Airlines (Delta connection) from Phoenix, Salt Lake City and Las Vegas.
