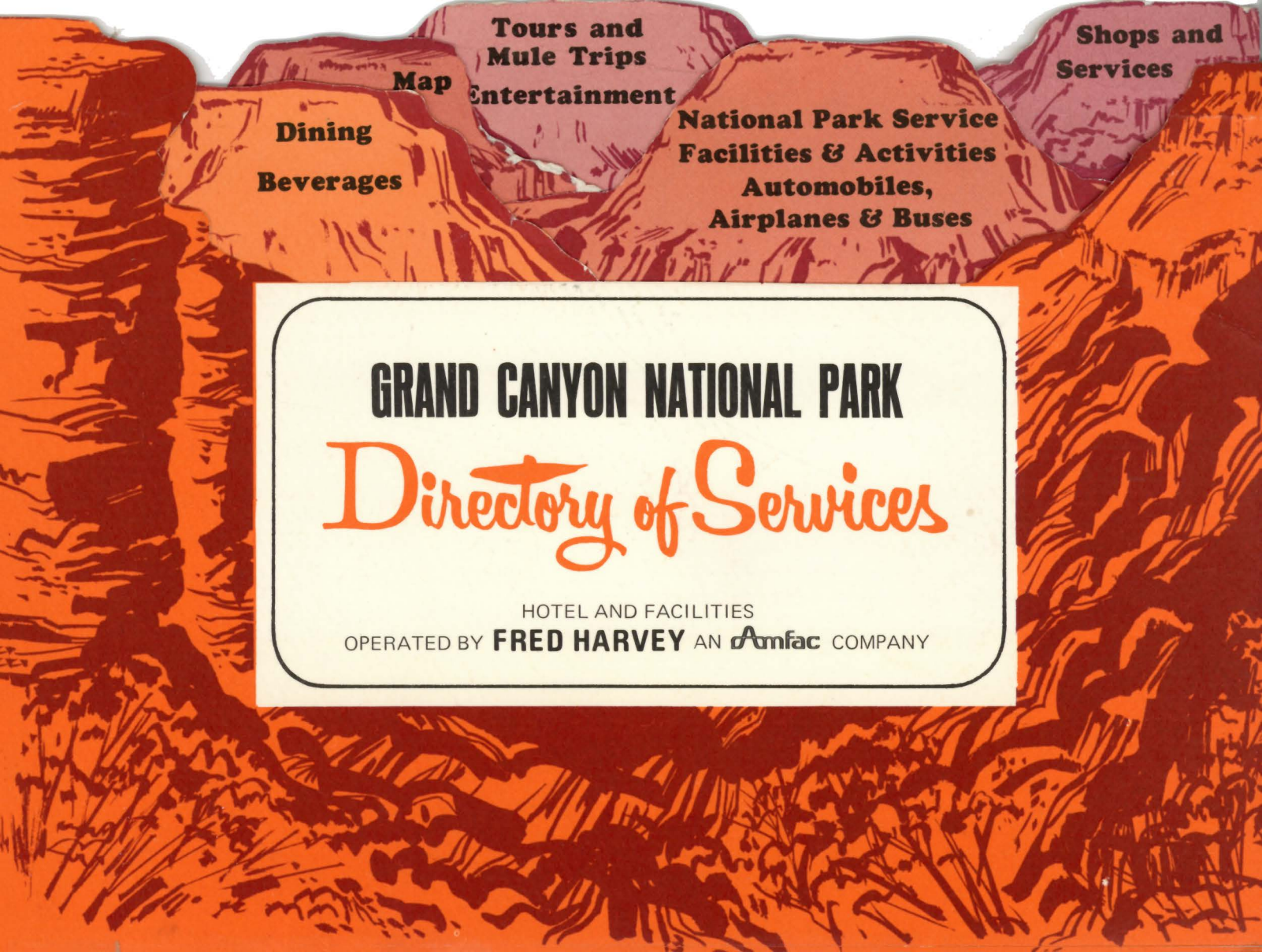

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Dining

Yavapai Center

Yavapai Fountain, Coffee Shop and Cafeteria located in shopping area by Visitor's Center.

El Tovar Dining Room

Bright Angel Coffee Shop

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National Park Service Facilities & Activities

Visitor Center

The Grand Canyon National Park Visitor Center is located three-quarters of a mile east of The El Tovar Hotel. Here are exhibits and information desks. Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (earlier and later during summer season). For telephone information you may call 2411 or 2245 (local outside call).

Tusayan Ruin and Museum

Near Desert View on the East Rim Drive. Museum is open during summer. Self-guiding trail through ruin open all year.

Call 2245 for general and special recorded program information.

Amphitheatre

Just behind the Visitor Center. During the summer interesting naturalist interpretative programs are presented at 8:00 p.m. For winter schedule, please call 2411 or 2245 (local outside call).

Yavapai Museum

Located on the "Rim" a short distance north and east of the Visitor Center. Featured are spectacular viewing points and exhibits. Open daily during summer. For winter schedule please call 2411 or 2245 (local outside call).

Automobiles, Airplanes & Buses

Airline Reservations

To make or confirm reservations, please consult the local telephone directory. Most airlines operating outside the area provide toll free service. Airplane and Helicopter Canyon tours may be arranged at Transportation Desks.

Rental Cars

Hertz car rentals may be arranged by calling Transportation Desk, Extension 576 or 577.

Service Station

A Chevron service station is located, for your convenience, just east of the National Park Service Visitor Center. Extension 588. All major credit cards accepted.

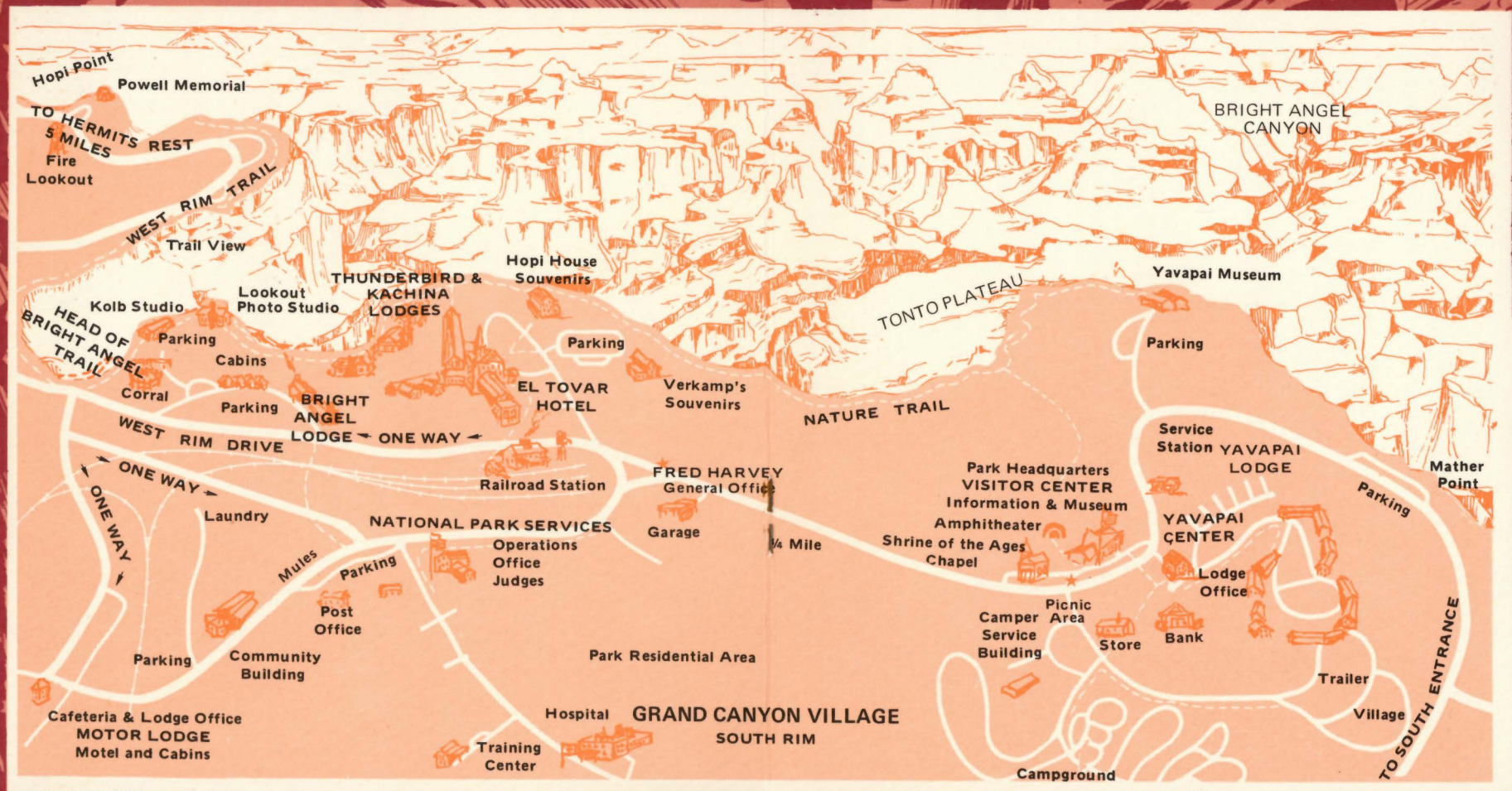
Bus Services

In addition to tours, Fred Harvey buses connect with all scheduled incoming and outgoing flights at Grand Canyon Airport. Other bus companies make scheduled trips to Flagstaff and Williams, connecting with major lines. For current schedules and reservations, dial 576 or 577.

Repair Garage

Tune-ups, towing service and major repairs are available at the repair garage located on the east end of the Fred Harvey Administrative Office Building at the foot of the El Tovar hill. For emergency service, dial the hotel operator.

Bus Tours

One of the best ways to view the Grand Canyon is by bus along the Rim. Experienced drivers narrate the trips and you will stop at many spectacular view points. You may choose from the following:

- * West Rim Drive to Hermit's Rest
- * East Rim Drive to Desert View and Watchtower
- * Combination East Rim and West Rim.

Mule Trips

For the ultimate Canyon experience, a trip into the Canyon on muleback is a must. You will ride gentle and trail-wise mules on well-maintained trails. Cowboys, well experienced in the Canyon, will be your guides. Full-day and overnight trips available. Reservations are required and should be made well in advance, especially for May through September.

What to Wear



Hiking boots are necessary for those persons who plan to hike extensively along the Rim or down into the Canyon. Riding clothes and sun hats are recommended for all Trail Trips. These can be rented at the Transportation Desk of Bright Angel Lodge. Summer—regular summer clothing and a wrap for cool evenings are all that are required unless the visitor plans to leave the Rim. Winter—warm clothing is necessary. Call 2245 for weather information.

Shops

El Tovar Gift Shop

A very fine selection of hand-made Indian jewelry, baskets and pottery and other giftware may be found on display for your selection. Postcards, magazines, newspapers and drug sundries.

Hopi House

Three-quarters of a century old houses the United States' finest collection of Indian jewelry and crafts. Hopi Room to be seen by appointment only. Located across the circle from the El Tovar Hotel.

Bright Angel Shop

Gifts, Indian Crafts, souvenirs, newsstand, drug sundries. In the Bright Angel Lodge building.

Spacious Yavapai Curio Shop

Indian crafts and pottery, news stand, drug sundries. Located at Yavapai Center.

Motor Lodge Shop

Located in the Cafeteria building across the square from the Motor Lodge Office. Selection of Canyon souvenirs, gifts, drug sundries and also a newsstand.

Hermif's Rest and Desert View

These shops are located at the ends of the East and West Rim Drives. Be certain to visit them when you take these trips.

Lookout Studio

Perched on the Rim a few hundred feet west of the Bright Angel Lodge, this quaint shop will be of particular interest to "rock hounds." A good selection of cameras and film. Excellent Canyon view.

CHECK OUT TIME – Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. If you arrive before that time, we are pleased to have you, but it is not always possible to have your accommodations ready for occupancy at that time.

CHURCH SERVICES – Roman Catholic, Community Church, Southern Baptist and Latter Day Saints services are conducted each Sunday in Grand Canyon Village. For times and locations, please consult notices which are conveniently posted in the various lobbies, or call your front desk for information.

CREDIT CARDS – Fred Harvey honors American Express, BankAmericard, Master Charge, Diners and Carte Blanche.

ICE – Ice is available at self-service machines conveniently located in each hotel area or registration area.

MAIL SERVICE – Please inquire at front desk for incoming mail. Post boxes are provided for outgoing mail or you may give to room clerk. Stamps are available at vendors near gift shops or at Post Office (for location please consult the map in the center fold of this directory).
