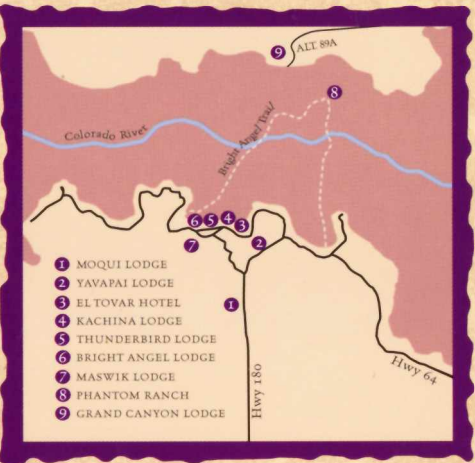

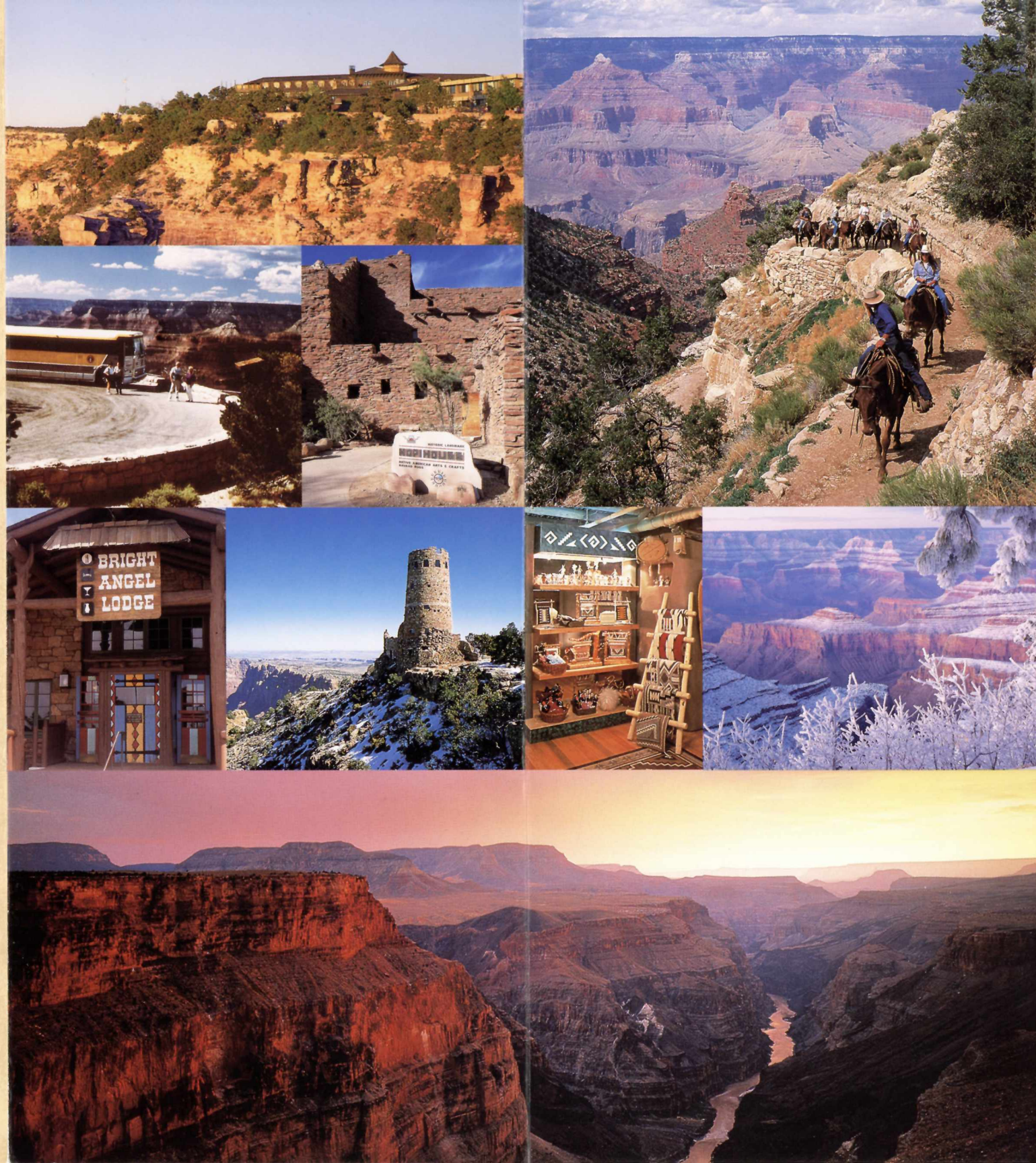


SOUTH RIM
