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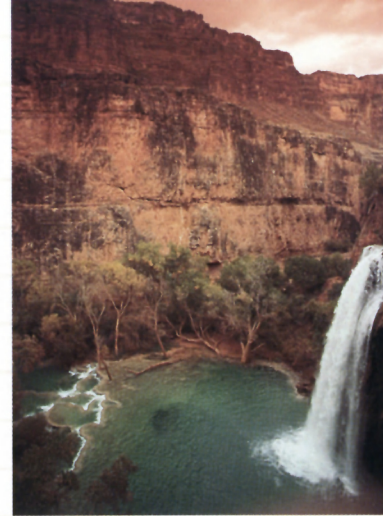
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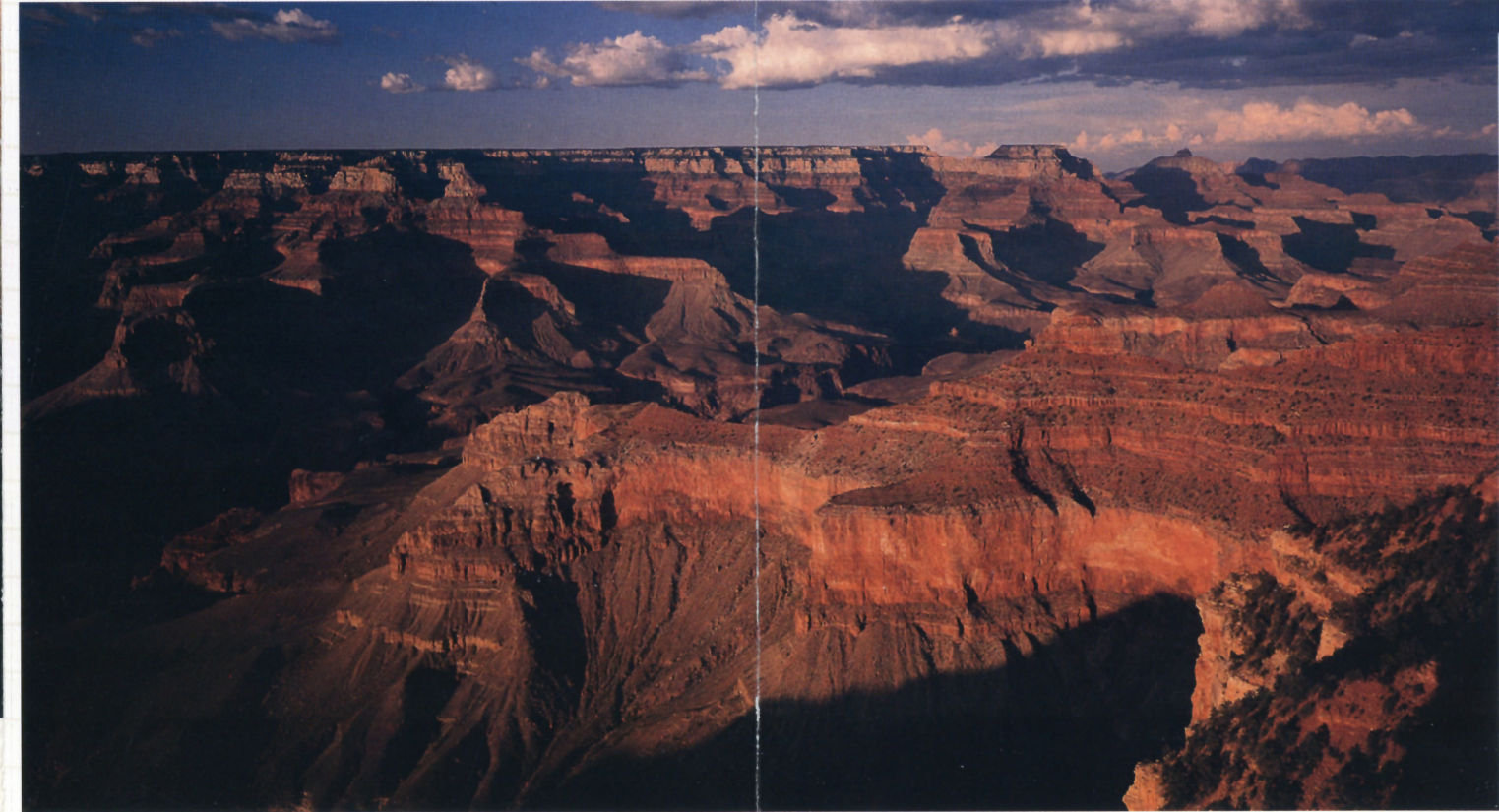

Thunderbird and Kachina are modern, two-story lodges. They feature both single and double rooms with superb year 'round views.

Maswik Lodge is our newest facility and it's located in the Canyon Village. It includes a cafeteria, lounge and gift shop.

East and West Yavapai are just minutes from the rim in the nearby pine and juniper. The lodge offers a gift shop, cafeteria and lounge.

Moqui Lodge is just outside the Park in the Kaibab National Forest. Moderately priced, the lodge features a dining room and cocktail lounge with on-site tennis courts, horseback riding, and cook-out areas.

Trailer Village is open year 'round and offers uncrowded sites with full hook-ups. Bath facilities are nearby and rates are moderate.

If you're looking for more adventure . . . one, two and three day mule trips will take you deep into the Canyon. Overnight lodging and meals are provided by Fred Harvey's Phantom Ranch . . . and fishing gear can be supplied on site. The dormitories are also used by groups of hikers.
