The Lodge Company operates historic Jackson Lake Lodge, rustically elegant Jenny Lake Lodge, and family oriented Colter Bay Village, where accommodations include log cabins, RV sites and tent cabins. Just outside the Park, the Grand Teton Lodge Company operates the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club. Facilities open to the public include the Strutting Grouse Restaurant & Lounge, 6 plexi-cushion tennis courts, Pro Shops and a challenging 18-hole golf course. Redesigned by Robert Trent Jones, Jr., the course is consistently rated among the nation's top resort courses by *Golf Digest*.

JACKSON LAKE LODGE

OPEN MID-MAY THROUGH MID-OCTOBER

A full-service resort hotel located in the heart of Grand Teton National Park. The Lodge is situated on a bluff overlooking Willow Flats offering spectacular views across the water of Jackson Lake to the skyline of the Tetons. There are 348 guest cottage rooms located on either side of the Lodge as well as 37 guest rooms in the main lodge building. Most rooms have two double beds. In keeping with the National Park location, rooms do not have TV's or radios. The Guest Lounge features 60-foot picture windows framing the Tetons as well as a collection of Indian artifacts and Western art. Meals are memorable in the Mural Room with its Rocky Mountain cuisine and breathtaking views. The Pioneer Grill offers counter service of light meals, snacks and soda fountain treats. And the Blue Heron cocktail lounge features live entertainment, your favorite beverage and great views. Guest facilities include gift and apparel shops, room service,

a quiet card room, a large heated, outdoor swimming pool, riding horses, float trips, a service station, and a medical clinic.

Conference facilities for groups of up to 500 people are available in May/June and in September/October; smaller meetings can be scheduled in July and August. Write or call for a Conference Brochure.

COLTER BAY VILLAGE

OPEN MID-MAY THROUGH LATE-SEPTEMBER

Located by the shores of Jackson Lake, Colter Bay Village offers a variety of accommodations as well as a full-service marina, two restaurants, a snack bar, a launderette and showers, a grocery store, gift and apparel shops, corrals and service stations. The National Park Service Visitors' Center, Indian Arts Museum and amphitheater are also located in Colter Bay Village.

COLTER BAY LOG CABINS

Set in a wooded area near Jackson Lake, these 208 snug log cabins come in a variety of sizes and configurations. Some sleep up to six persons. A few are original settlers' cabins. Most cabins have a complete bath with shower (no tubs). No kitchen facilities are available.

COLTER BAY TENT CABINS

Tent Village offers truly deluxe camping. The spacious tent cabins are constructed of canvas and logs. Each has an outdoor grill, woodburning stove, two double-decker bunks (without bedding) and a picnic table. Sheet lined sleeping bags, cooking utensils, ice chests, etc. may be rented at a central utility building. Restroom facilities with hot running water are provided. Showers are not included, but are available for a fee.

COLTER BAY RV PARK

A fully equipped RV park offers 112 trailer spaces, each with sewer, electrical and water connections and picnic table. Most sites are pull through and shaded. Showers are not included, but are available for a fee.

ACTIVITIES IN THE TETONS

JACKSON LAKE CRUISES

Enjoy a 1 1/2 hour narrated scenic cruise or spend a little longer and enjoy a meal on picturesque Elk Island.

SCENIC LAKE CRUISE - Morning and afternoon departures daily; allow 1 1/2 hours.

BREAKFAST CRUISE - Early morning departures Sunday through Friday; allow 3 hours.

EVENING STEAK FRY - Afternoon departures on Wednesday and Saturday; allow 3 hours.

BOAT RENTALS

The waters of Jackson Lake are perfect to explore by canoe, rowboat or 9.9 hp motor boat.

Rented daily at the Colter Bay Marina. No advance reservations.

SCENIC SNAKE RIVER FLOAT TRIPS

A float trip with our experienced river guides offers an extra special view of the Snake River and the Tetons.

SCENIC FLOAT TRIP - Morning and afternoon departures daily; allow 3-4 hours.

LUNCHEON FLOAT TRIP - Morning departures daily; allow 4-5 hours.

EVENING SUPPER FLOAT TRIP - Afternoon departures Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday; allow 4-5 hours.

Children must be six years old.

HORSEBACK RIDES

For an hour or a half-day, a guided horseback ride is a spectacular way to view Grand Teton National Park.

GUIDED TRAIL RIDES - Morning and afternoon departures daily; varied ride lengths.

BREAKFAST TRAIL RIDE - Early morning departures Tuesday through Sunday; allow 3-4 hours.

DINNER TRAIL RIDE - Afternoon departures Tuesday through Sunday; allow 3-4 hours.

Children must be eight years old and four feet tall to ride a horse. Riders must not exceed 225 pounds.

SCENIC PARK BUS TOURS

A narrated bus tour is a great way to be introduced to the wonders of this area and some of its rich history.

GRAND TETON

NATIONAL PARK TOUR - Half-day tour leaves early on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings.

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK TOUR - Full-day tour includes a box lunch and leaves early on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings.

FISHING

Whether fishing on Jackson Lake or fly fishing on one of the area's many streams or rivers, our guides will take you to the most likely area for your catch. Reservations are strongly recommended.

GUIDED FLY FISHING - make reservations at the Moose Village Store after mid-May. 307-733-3471.

RESERVATIONS

ROOMS - Reservations should be made as early as possible and accompanied by a one-night deposit for Colter Bay Village and a two-night deposit for Jackson Lake Lodge. Deposits must be made by check or money order. Deposits will be refunded if notice of cancellation is received two days prior to arrival date. Three nights' deposit is required for Jenny Lake Lodge reservations and will be refunded provided notice of cancellation is received three weeks prior to arrival.

ACTIVITIES - Advance reservations for activities are strongly recommended. Full pre-payment is required in order to reserve an activity. Pre-payment must be by check or money order. You must check in or call 24 hours before your scheduled activity to confirm your reservation. Refunds will be made if an activity is cancelled 24 hours before the scheduled time.

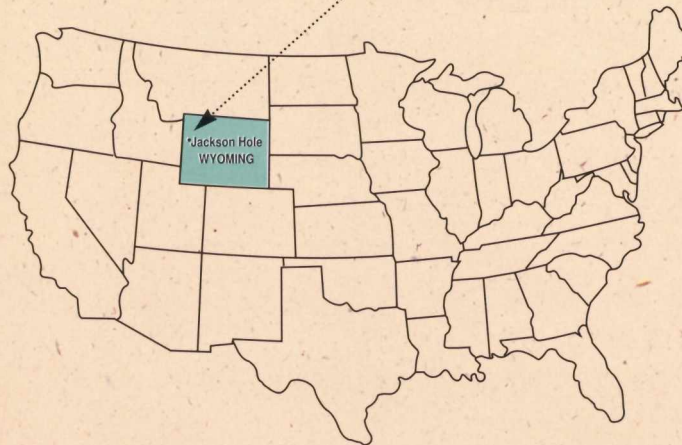
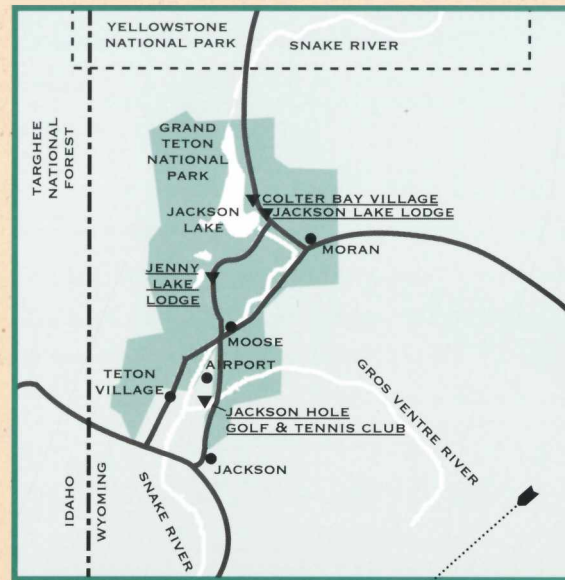
OUTSIDE THE PARK

Park visitors and guests are invited to use the facilities of the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club. The clubhouse is located just off Hwy. #89, eight miles north of Jackson. Casual dining is available for lunch and dinner at the Strutting Grouse Restaurant. Six plexi-cushion tennis courts provide the opportunity for some great tennis and the 18-hole, par 72-championship golf course redesigned by Robert Trent Jones, Jr. is rated among the top resort courses in the nation by *Golf Digest*.

The small Western town of Jackson offers a variety of activities - art galleries and museums, old-time saloons, Western melodramas and rodeos. Teton Village has a tram ride with marvelous views of Jackson Hole.

WHAT TO WEAR

Dress is usually informal, with the emphasis on comfort. Days are usually warm, so have lightweight sportswear with you. A sturdy pair of walking shoes or hiking boots, blue jeans and bathing suits will add to your comfort and enjoyment. In short, plan for an active outdoor life. Evenings are cool, so warm clothing is desirable. The mountain sun burns stronger through the thinner air, so bring your suntan lotion and your sunglasses along.



EASY TO GET HERE

AUTO: Four major highways serve Jackson Hole: US 26, 89, 187, 287

AIR: Daily air service is available through Denver, Colorado and Salt Lake City, Utah to the Jackson Hole Airport. Grand Teton Lodge Company buses meet most flights. There is a per person charge, each way, for airport bus service (does not include Park entrance fee).

BUS: Grand Teton Lodge Company buses go into the town of Jackson twice daily.

Park entry fees are collected by National Park Service at entrance gates.

ABOUT OUR FACILITIES

- None of our rooms have televisions or radios. Only the rooms at Jackson Lake Lodge have telephones.
- FAX services are available at the Front Desk at Jackson Lake Lodge and Jenny Lake Lodge. UPS and Federal Express stop daily at Jackson Lake Lodge.
- None of our rooms have kitchen facilities.
- Pets are allowed in some cottages at Jackson Lake Lodge and Colter Bay Village but must be kept on a leash. Pets are not allowed at Jenny Lake Lodge.
- All Grand Teton Lodge Company public areas are non-smoking and 70% of our rooms are non-smoking.
- The swimming pool at Jackson Lake Lodge is available to registered guests from Jenny Lake Lodge and Colter Bay Village Cabins as well as Jackson Lake Lodge guests.

ABOUT ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES & SERVICES

- National Park Ranger Naturalist programs and guided nature hikes are available throughout the Park.
- Church services are held at Jackson Lake Lodge and Colter Bay Village.
- Our Snake River Float trip is scenic, not whitewater. We can book whitewater raft trips for our guests upon arrival.
- Our Chefs will cook the fish you catch. Fish must be cleaned.

ABOUT SHOPPING

- There is an outstanding selection of gifts, clothing, outdoor equipment and accessories at Jackson Lake Lodge, Colter Bay Village, the Jenny Lake Store, and the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club Pro Shops.
- There is a convenience store at the Colter Bay Highway Service Station and a fully stocked grocery store at Colter Bay Village.

ABOUT THE AREA

- "Hole" is a term used to describe a high mountain valley. Jackson Hole is fifty miles long and fifteen miles wide. The town of Jackson, Wyoming, is at the southern end of the Hole and Jackson Lake Lodge and Colter Bay Village are at the northern end of the Hole.
- The altitude in Jackson Hole is 6,200 - 7,000 feet above sea level.
- The only regular bus service within the Park is the Shuttle Bus between Jackson Lake Lodge and Colter Bay Village. There are regularly scheduled daytime runs at a nominal charge.
- If you are flying into Jackson Hole Airport, you may want to rent a car to more fully enjoy your visit (advance reservations are usually required).
- There is a medical clinic at Jackson Lake Lodge and a hospital in Jackson.
