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Garage (WY-113-D):

The garage is one of the largest structures on the site. This one and a half story building has no foundation, and measures 24'-11" by 20'-4" in dimension. The walls, as well as the door to the garage, are board and batten. There are two six pane fixed sash windows and the roof of the garage is a steep pitched front gable with open rafters, exposed rafter eave ends and is covered with aluminum panels. A driveway, constructed of packed earth and log retaining walls, slopes from the garage to the road.
