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Outhouse (WY-113-G):

The outhouse is a one story wood frame structure which is sided with vertical half logs and has no foundation. The overall dimensions of this structure are 6'-8" by 5'-6". There are two board and batten doors, and the roof of the outhouse is a normal pitched front gable with open rafters, exposed rafter eave ends and asphalt roll roofing.
