Tool House (WY-113-H):

The tool house is a one story rectangular board and batten structure, whose overall dimensions are 13'-7" by 19'-8". There is no foundation on which the structure rests. The door to this building is board and batten, with iron strap hinges, and there is a single 6/6 pane sliding sash window. The roof of the tool house is a normal pitched front gable with open rafters, exposed rafter eave ends, and asphalt roll roofing.
