



Campgrounds



Nāmakaniipaio Campground

There are two drive-in campgrounds located within the park. Camping is free of charge. Entrance fees to Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park apply and may be paid at the entrance station (\$10 per car—valid for seven days, or a Hawai'i Annual Tri-Park, Interagency Annual, Senior, or Access Pass is valid for entry). Campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis with no reservations, no permits, and no check-in. Stays are limited to seven consecutive days per month, not to exceed 30 days per year.

Nāmakaniipaio Campground	Located on Highway 11 (mile marker 31) at 4,000 feet (1,213 m) in elevation. It is a large, open grassy area with tall eucalyptus and 'ōhi'a trees. This campground has restrooms and water. Fires are allowed in designated fire grates only. Wood may be purchased in Volcano Village. There is a large pavilion with picnic tables and fireplaces that is shared by	all campers. Dogs are allowed, but must be on a leash at all times. Weather may be cool and damp year-round. Daytime temperature ranges in the 60's to 70's degrees F (16 to 26 degrees C) with nighttime temperatures in the high 30's to low 50's (3 to 11 degrees C).
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Kulanaokuaiki Campground	Located off Hilina Pali Road at 3,200 feet (975 m). There are eight walk-in campsites with picnic tables—two are wheelchair accessible. There is an accessible vault toilet; however, no water is available and campfires	are not permitted. Use fueled camping stoves only. This campground is subject to closure when the area is dry and during times of high fire risk. No dogs or pets are allowed.
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Nearby Facilities	Showers Located at Nāmakaniipaio Campground and may be rented through the Volcano House hotel (808-967-7321) on a space available basis. Cabins Located at Nāmakaniipaio Campground and may be reserved through the Volcano House hotel (808-967-7321). Laundromat Located behind the Thai Thai Restaurant in Volcano Village.	Stores Volcano Village has two small general stores with gasoline and a hardware store. The nearest large shopping area is in Hilo, 28 miles north of Volcano Village. Restaurants There are several restaurants located in Volcano Village, the Volcano Golf and Country Club, and within the park.
