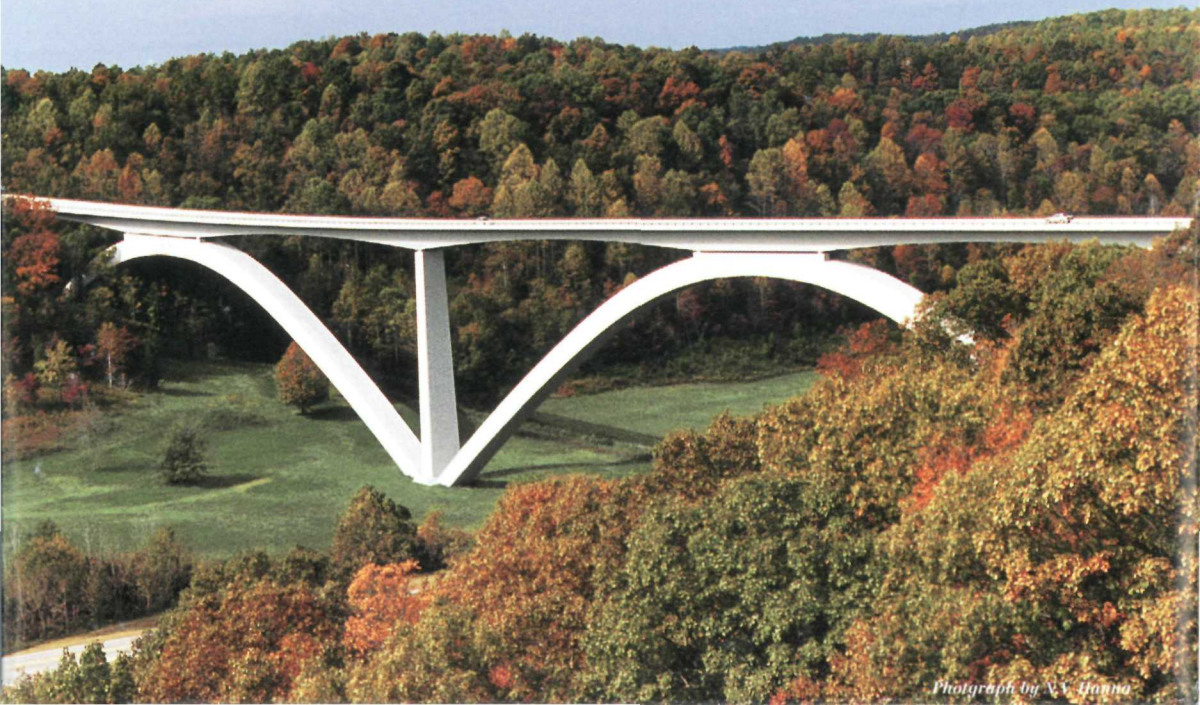

The Gatlinburg Spur, Foothills Parkway

Great Smoky Mountains National Park

This connector road, which proceeds through a tunnel and crosses a bridge, was reconstructed 3 ft below its former grade to improve safety.

Cumberland Gap Tunnel, Tennessee Portal

Cumberland Gap National Historical Park

This tunnel, which runs from Cumberland Gap, Tennessee, to Middlesboro, Kentucky, was constructed to permit restoration of the historic Cumberland Gap to its 1700's appearance and to improve traffic safety.

Forehand Hollow Bridge, Natchez Trace Parkway

This 900-ft-long bridge rises 100 feet above the basin floor as it curves gracefully into the woodlands.

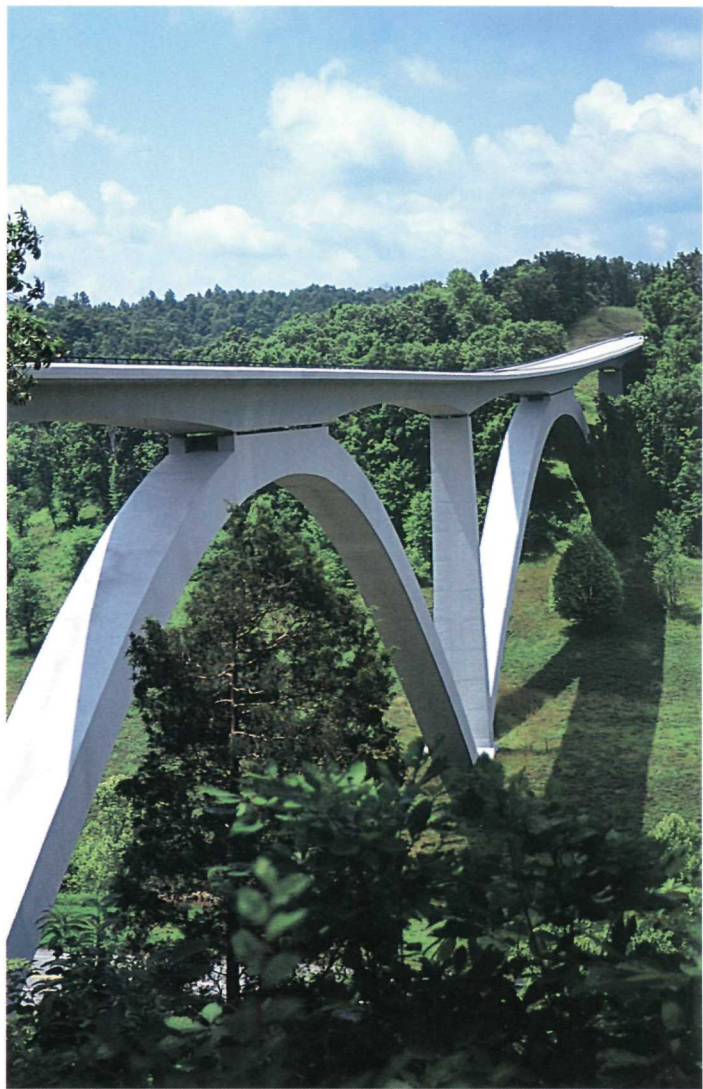
Clara Barton Parkway

Voyageurs National Park

International Falls, MN

New 3.2-mi entrance road to the Ash River Visitor Center, Voyageurs National Park, Minnesota. The waterways of the park were vital to the voyageurs, who were French-Canadian canoemen actively engaged in fur trading in the late 18th and early 19th centuries.

Linn Cove Viaduct—Blue Ridge Parkway

Grandfather Mountain, North Carolina

This viaduct crosses a huge boulder field and is precariously perched on the south face of Grandfather Mountain. The viaduct completes part of the missing link of the Blue Ridge Parkway that extends 470 miles from North Carolina to Virginia.
