25 for 25 Challenge





## Do you have what it takes to complete the 25 for 25 Challenge?

Complete at least 10 of the 25 challenges to earn your 25th Anniversary Challenge Coin. At least 4 of the 10 challenges must be Park Challenges.

<b>6.</b> Download the NPS App and use the battlefield trail guide to walk the trail.
7. Walk the Battlefield Trail x2 Write the date on the lines for each day the trail was walked.
8. Walk the Dust and Fire Trail x5 Write the date on the lines for each day the trail was walked.
<b>9.</b> Go out to the battlefield and find the old railroad bed. Take a picture standing on it.
10. Watch three videos on the Washita Battlefield NHS website or Facebook page.
11. Search the Washita Battlefield NHS website to read about Clara Blinn and find one of the three artifacts of her's located in the museum.
