

Jewel Cave National
Monument, located 13
miles west of Custer,
South Dakota on U.S.
Highway 16, is open
daily and offers several
different cave tours.


The Visitor Center contains exhibits explaining the cave and its formations. Information and printed materials are available at the Visitor Center.

The temperature in Jewel Cave is approximately 47° F (8.3° C) year round. A light jacket or sweater and low-heeled walking shoes with non-slip soles are required for both the Scenic and Historic Trail tours.

Cave tours are not recommended for anyone with heart or respiratory problems or for anyone recovering from a recent illness or hospital stay.

For visitors not able to negotiate tour trails free trips by elevator into one room of the cave are offered and can be arranged by contacting a Ranger at the Visitor Center information desk.


Scenic Tour



The Scenic Trail Tour enters and leaves the cave by elevator from the Visitor Center.
Indirect lighting along the Scenic Trail emphasizes the colors and variety of formations found in the heart of the known cave.

The tour along this 1/2 mile trail lasts 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 hours. The tour is moderately strenuous and requires climbing long flights of steps.


Spelunking Tour



The Spelunking Trail
Tour is designed for
those visitors 16 years
old and older who want
to experience the cave
in its natural state and
on its own terms.
Visitors learn about low
impact caving, caving
techniques and safety,
and caving equipment.
The park provides
helmets and lights;
visitors are expected to
provide any other needed
equipment, including a

change of clothing and ankle high, lug soled, lace up boots. This 2/3 mile, 4 - 5 hour trip is extremely strenuous and each participant is required to pass through an 8 1/2" by 24" practice crawl prior to entering the cave. Advance reservations are recommended and may be obtained up to 60 days in advance by writing or calling the park.

Historic Tour




The Historic Trail Tour enters and leaves the cave through the natural entrance. This candlelight tour offers visitors the chance to see the cave as early visitors saw it. This strenuous 1/2 mile tour

lasts 1 1/2 to 2 hours and requires climbing steep wooden steps, and bending and stooping along an uneven unpaved trail. The Historic Tours is for visitors 6 years old and older.
