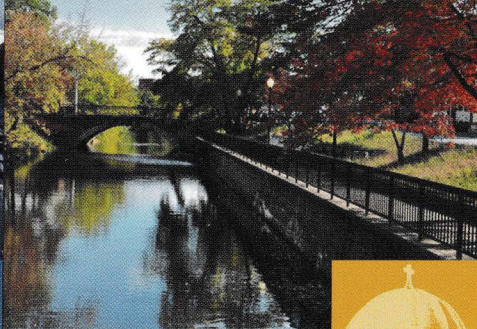
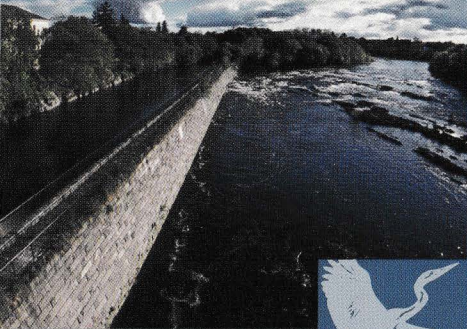

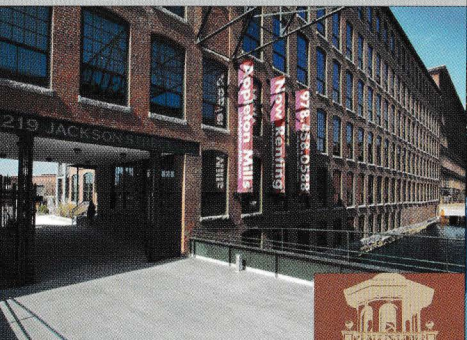

Redevelopment Rove

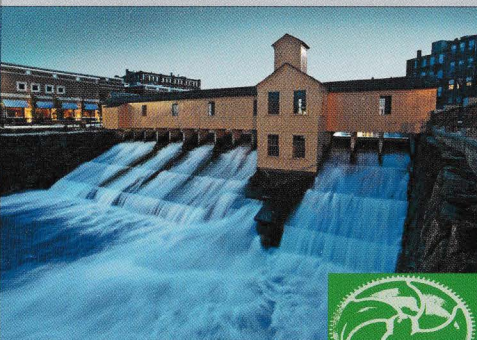
Learn how historic mill complexes and canalside spaces are transformed into a vibrant mixed-use neighborhood that will serve as a dramatic new gateway for the city.

Walk the Western Canalway through Lowell's storied "Acre" neighborhood and explore the rich history and vibrant culture of the many ethnic groups who have called this city home.

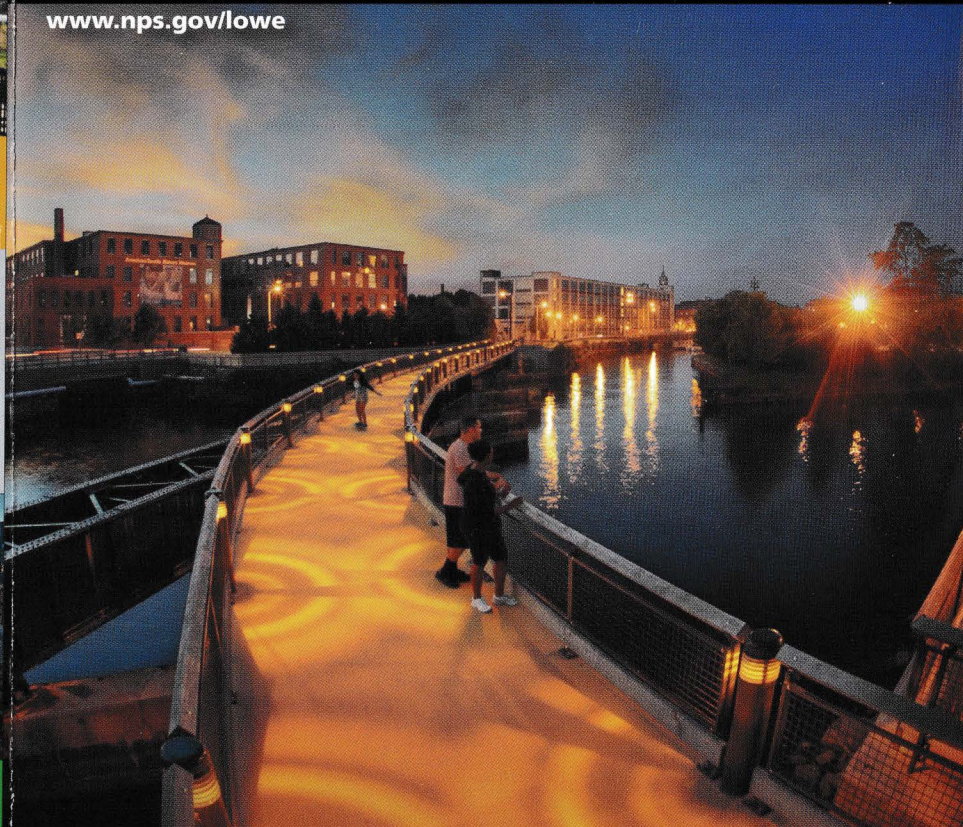
