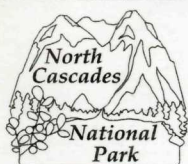

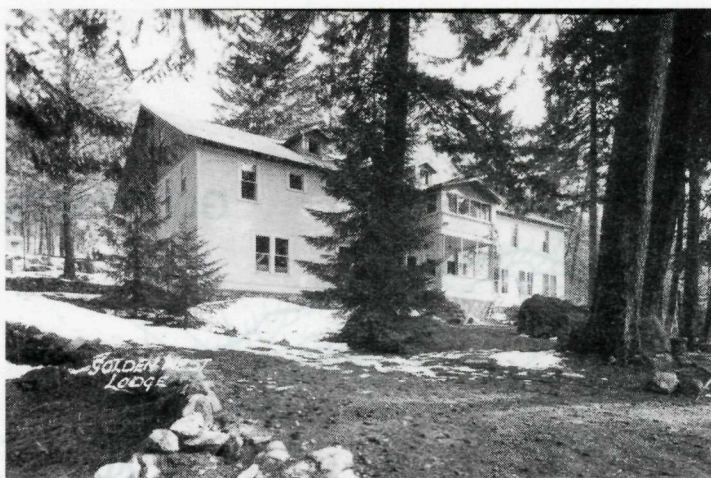

North Cascades National Park Service Complex, located in north-central Washington State, is characterized by a mix of jagged mountain peaks, glaciers, lush and diverse forests, and tumbling waterfalls. The park complex includes North Cascades National Park and Ross Lake and Lake Chelan National Recreation Areas. Lake Chelan National Recreation Area encompasses the upper 4.5 miles of Lake Chelan and remote Stehekin, nestled in the glacier-carved Stehekin Valley. The small community of Stehekin has no road connections to the rest of the world. Visitors and residents arrive by passenger ferry, private boat, floatplane, horseback, and on foot. Trails into large areas of wilderness branch off the Stehekin Valley Road ascending to the rugged mountains. The road begins at the boat landing and follows the meandering Stehekin River to Cottonwood Camp, 23 miles upvalley.

Stehekin is a treasure of significant natural and cultural features including the historic Golden West Lodge. Built in 1926 utilizing portions of the old Field Hotel, the lodge provided overnight accommodations until 1972. Beginning in the summer of 2001, the historic lodge will undergo renovation and rebuilding to strengthen its structural integrity. The building's features that are important from an historical perspective will be retained. Upon completion, it will function as the National Park Service district office while continuing to serve as the park visitor center. New exhibits will compliment the historic fabric of the building while conveying a sense of the unique natural and cultural history of the Stehekin Valley and the park complex.



Getting to Stehekin

Lake Chelan Boat Company: Passenger boats provide round-trip transportation service between Chelan and Stehekin with scheduled stops at Field's Point and Lucerne. Daily service is available from March 15th through October 31st with reduced service during the winter months. Prices vary by vessel and season. Write Lake Chelan Boat Company at P.O. Chelan Airways: Flights to and from Stehekin scheduled daily during summer months and on reduced schedules during the winter. Flight tours 15 to 30 minutes in length available - prices variable. Write to Chelan Airways, P.O. Box W, Chelan, WA 98816 or call (509) 682-5555.



Stehekin Transportation

The 23-mile Stehekin Valley Road is paved for four miles from Stehekin Landing and becomes gravel at Harlequin Campground. Views of the Stehekin River, glacier-clad jagged peaks, and dense coniferous forests are found along the way. Transportation is offered along the road for your enjoyment and convenience. Drivers provide a

narrated tour, as well as camping and hiking information. You may get on or off the buses at any location. Infant seats are available on the NPS bus.

Stehekin Valley Road Status: Beyond High Bridge, 11 miles from the landing, many sections of the road were damaged by the floods of November '95. At present, the road is open to Glory Mountain, 20.1 miles from Stehekin Landing. Above Glory Mountain, a channel of the river flows down the road for approximately 3000'. Due to this damage, the road will remain closed for 2.7 miles between Glory Mountain and Cottonwood Camp until conditions change and the road can be repaired. A trail is maintained along the damaged section of road. Hikers and horseback parties are able to use this trail. Bicycles are allowed, but not recommended. Ask a ranger about latest conditions on the road.

National Park Service Shuttle Van: Reservations are strongly recommended to guarantee a seat and can be made in person, at ranger stations in Stehekin, Chelan, Marblemount, North Cascades Visitor Center in Newhalem and Sedro-Woolley Information Station. Reservations may be made in advance by calling the Purple Point Information Center at (360) 856-5700, ext. 340, then ext. 14 from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm after May 14. Long-term reservations must be reconfirmed by telephone or in person between 2 and 4 days in advance of the bus ride or departure on trail. Otherwise, the reservations will be cancelled. Buses do not leave specified points before the scheduled times.

Vehicle, road, or other problems sometimes cause delays and adjustments to schedules. Call ahead for current road conditions.

The Stehekin Shuttle (lower valley): This bus runs from Stehekin Landing to High Bridge. The bus accommodates backpacks and bicycles. No reservations are required for this 36-passenger bus. A *Bakery Special* ride between Stehekin Landing and the Stehekin Pastry Company is available for \$1 one way.

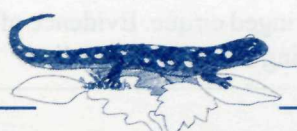

Purple Point Information Center

The National Park Service staffs the Purple Point Information Center from mid-March through mid-October (8:30 am - 5:00 pm daily with reduced hours in spring and fall). Be sure to stop by the information center, located a short distance uplake from (see inset map) the landing, where you can find the following:

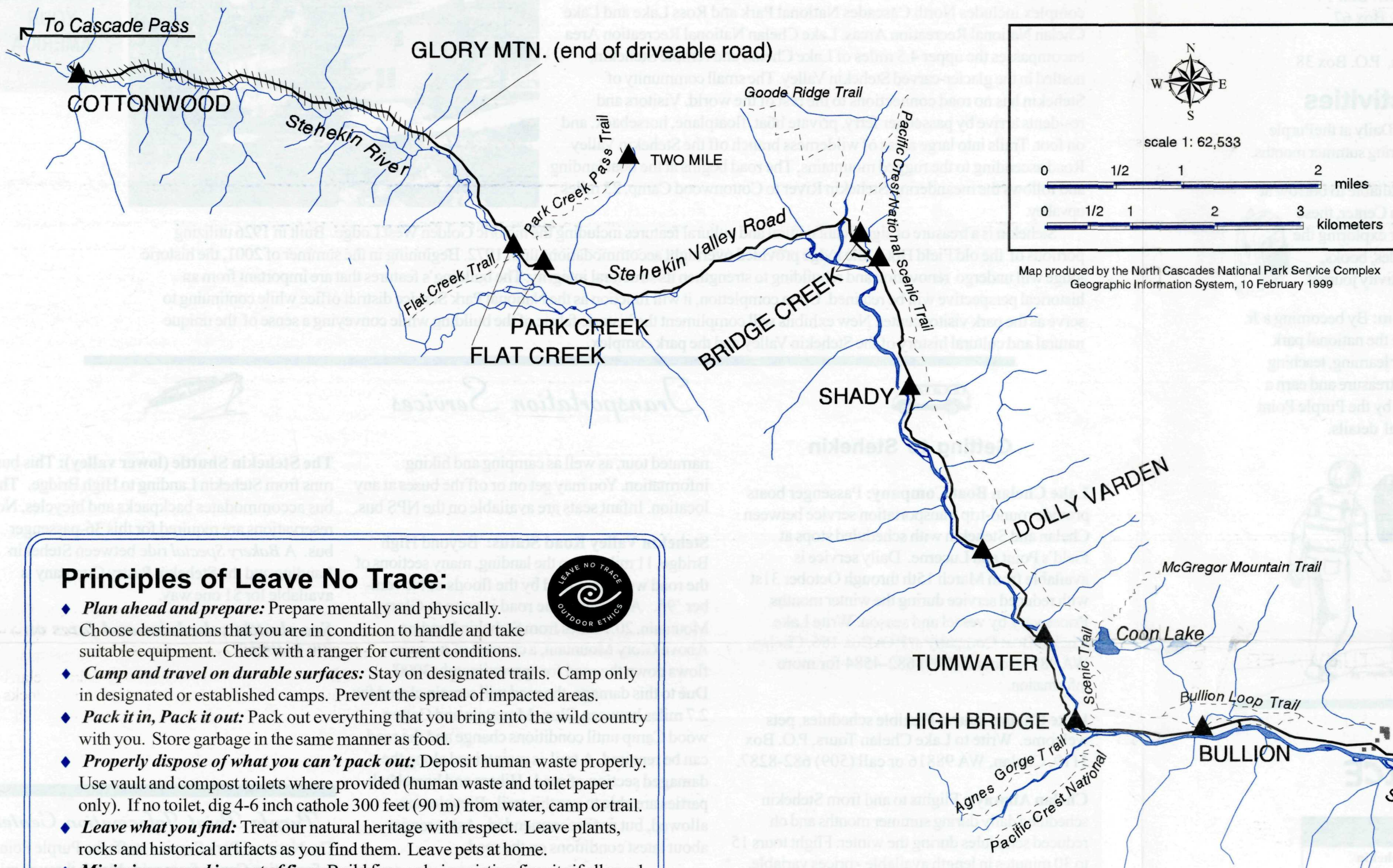
- **Rangers** available to assist you with trail information, backcountry permits and general information about the area.
- **Naturalist Programs** including evening programs, children's programs and short-talks presented daily on a variety of natural and cultural history topics.
- **Exhibits and Relief Map**
- **The Golden West Gallery** displaying artwork related to Stehekin and the North Cascades by area artists. Programs and workshops presented by the artists throughout the summer.
- **"A Wilderness Place"** ten-minute slide program which can be viewed any time. This presentation includes narration and images of Stehekin and the surrounding wilderness area.

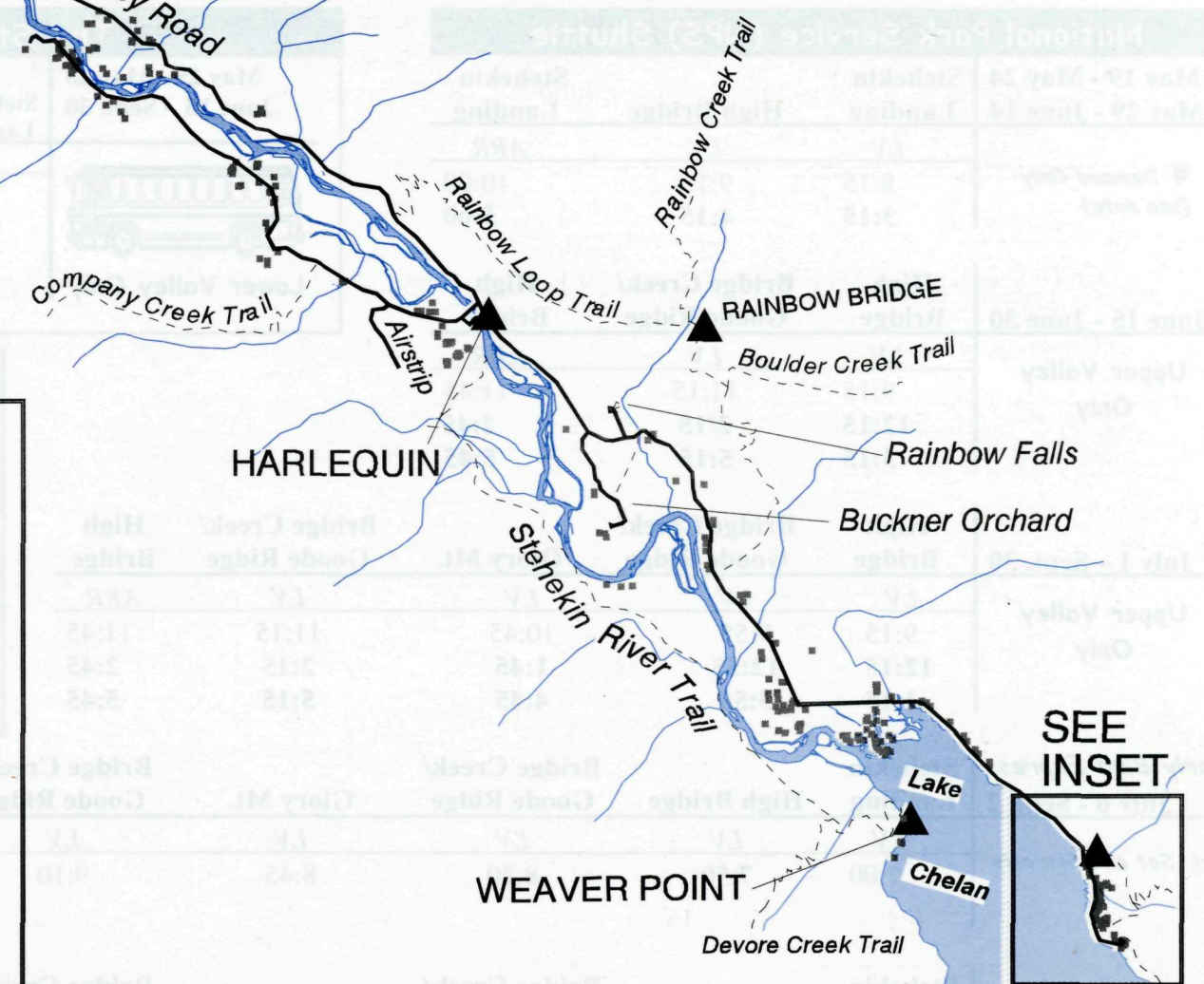
Principles of Leave No Trace:

- ◆ **Plan ahead and prepare:** Prepare mentally and physically. Choose destinations that you are in condition to handle and take suitable equipment. Check with a ranger for current conditions.
- ◆ **Camp and travel on durable surfaces:** Stay on designated trails. Camp only in designated or established camps. Prevent the spread of impacted areas.
- ◆ **Pack it in, Pack it out:** Pack out everything that you bring into the wild country with you. Store garbage in the same manner as food.
- ◆ **Properly dispose of what you can't pack out:** Deposit human waste properly. Use vault and compost toilets where provided (human waste and toilet paper only). If no toilet, dig 4-6 inch cathole 300 feet (90 m) from water, camp or trail.
- ◆ **Leave what you find:** Treat our natural heritage with respect. Leave plants, rocks and historical artifacts as you find them. Leave pets at home.
- ◆ **Minimize use and impact of fires:** Build fires only in existing firepits if allowed.



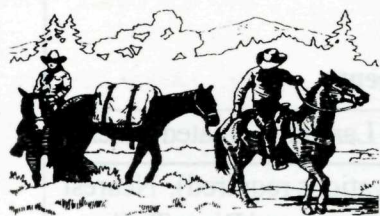
- ➔ Free backcountry permits are needed for overnight stays at all North Cascades National Park Service Complex camps. Permits available at Ranger Stations on a first-come, first-served basis up to a day in advance.
- ➔ Reservation requests for group camps must be made in writing: National Park Service, PO Box 7, Stehekin, WA 98852. For further information call (360) 856-5700 ext 340 then ext 14.
- ➔ **No NPS backcountry permit needed for Lake Chelan boat-in sites except if camping at Purple Point. Use of all federal docks on Lake Chelan requires a U.S. Forest Service dock permit, costing \$5 per day or \$40 for the season (May 1 through October 31).

Activities and Services

Cascade Corrals: Horse supported hiking and riding trips into the Cascades are available. For trip times and costs visit the Courtney Log Office located 200 yards from the boat landing or write to Cascade Corrals, Box 67, Stehekin, WA 98852.



The House That Jack Built: located near the visitor center. For sale are a variety of handcrafted items including t-shirts, cards and jewelry made by residents of Stehekin. The store is open during the summer.

Laundry and Shower Facilities: Public telephone, coin operated laundry and shower located 200 yards uplake from Landing.

McGregor Mountain Outdoor Supply: offers boating, hiking and backpacking supplies, hunting and fishing licenses and gear and a variety of books, maps, trail foods, snacks, souvenirs and apparel. Located near the Golden West. Open daily April - Oct. 15.



North Cascades Stehekin Lodge: Call (509) 682-4494. Services include:

- **Store:** Small selection of food items, gifts and souvenirs.
- **Boat & Bicycle Rentals:** Mountain bike and boat rentals by the hour or day.
- **High Bridge Bus and Lunch Tour:** Picnic lunch and narrated bus tour to High Bridge daily during summer months.
- **Rainbow Falls Bus Tour:** Narrated bus trip to the 312' falls. Tour leaves Stehekin Landing upon arrival of all passenger vessels.
- **Taxi Service:** Year-round.

Rafting the Stehekin River: Raft the lower 11 miles of the Stehekin River. See Stehekin Valley Ranch under *Accommodations* for reservation information.



Stehekin Discovery Bikes: Mountain bike rentals by the hour or day. Feature trip is Ranch Breakfast Ride. Stop by Courtney Log Office or write P.O. Box 8, Stehekin WA 98852.



Stehekin Pastry Company: Located 1.9 miles from the Landing. The bakery offers fresh baked goods, coffee, refreshments and ice cream. Open daily June to September.

Winter Activities: Recreational activities are available throughout the year. Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing are popular winter pursuits. North Cascades Stehekin Lodge offers transportation to and from ski and snowshoe destinations and rents snowshoes. Contact the North Cascades Stehekin Lodge for more information.
