OVERCOAT OR COAT MEASURE

Take With Coat On.

From Collar Seam 1 to Waist 2
From Collar Seam 1 to full length 3
Width of back 4 to Seam 5
Arm at right angle from 4 to 6
Sleeve Length from 4 to 7
REMOVE COAT and measure well up under arms Around Breast OVER VEST at H
Around Waist at 17 over Trousers
Around Seat at 18 take over Trousers

VEST MEASURE

Opening from Collar Seam to First Button
Length 22 to 24
Breast at H
Waist at 17
Take over Trousers

TROUSER MEASURE

From top of hip bone at 12 (not including waist-band) to 14 heel of shoe
Inseam from 15 to 16. Draw tape well up and measure to heel of shoe
Waist at No. 17
Seat at No. 18
Take "actual" seat Mark whether "full" or "half peg" or "regular". We make proper allowance.
Knee Size Wanted
Bottom Size Wanted

BREECHES MEASURE

Outside seam from hip bone 2 (not including waist band) to top of shoe at 6.
Inseam from Crotch (7 to 8) This length is usually about 5 in. less than ordinary trousers.
Around Waist at 2
Seat at No. 3
Take "actual" seat measure. Mark whether "full" or "half-peg" or "regular."
Around Knee at 9
Around the leg (in hollow) 2 1/2 in. below the knee at 10.
Around Calf (Snug) at 11
Around Ankle (Snug) at 6
Also give regular Pants inseam
