ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow instructions and reduce order delivery time.

FILLING OUT UNIFORM ORDER FORMS

- Make sure order form is current. The expiration date will be printed on the order form. If the form is out
 of date please contact the uniform coordinator in the park for current order forms.
- Print name, park, and account number. Be very careful to use correct account number which is the first seven digits of social security number.
- Fill out all size information utilizing the sizing instruction sheet provided on page 13 of this catalog and enter in space provided under listing of "Important Size Information."
- Enter size in column provided next to description of item ordered. If sizes cannot be determined then
 R & R Uniforms will use size information provided to determine proper size garments. Any additional
 information can be added in lines provided for special instructions.
 - NOTE: We hem all trousers to inseam or outseam measurement. Short, regular, and long refer to different rise available. Please see page 13 on sizing instructions for detailed explanation. Make sure inseam or outseam measurement is entered on order.
- Extend and total order entering grand total in line provided. It would be best to double check all figures
 as a mistake will result in a delay of order being processed.
- Include with order the amount of any overage in check, money order, Visa or Master Card. If Visa or Master Card is used, print card number and expiration date clearly. The minimum amount that can be charged to Master Card or Visa is \$5.00.
- Keep second copy of order for record of purchase.

FILLING OUT EXCHANGE FORMS

- Print name, park, and account number. Be very careful to use correct account number which is the first seven digits of social security number.
- Use this form for exchanges and returns for credit only. Use regular order forms for new orders.
- Indicate size and quantity received as well as size wanted. For any additional instructions print on exchange form itself.
- Remove the yellow (back) copy for a record of the exchange. Please remove back carbon before exchange
 form is shipped with return garments. We have had numerous garments ruined because the carbon has
 stained the garments during shipment.
- Please fill out return address in the space provided indicated by word "FROM" at the bottom of the exchange form. This will speed up return of exchange as this is used for return address label.
- Send the front two copies of exchange form with shipment.
- Prepare return shipping box as securely as possible. The U.S. Post Office and United Parcel Service
 can be very rough on boxes and have damaged some merchandise.

SPECIAL ORDERS AND TAPERING

- For sizes not listed as stock in catalog, please contact R & R Uniforms for special ordering instructions.
- Shirt tapering is available at \$4.00 per shirt. Indicate in special instructions section of order. Be sure to
 include in order total.


MEASURING INFORMATION

MALE

HOW TO MEASURE FOR SIZE:

HAVE SOMEONE ELSE MEASURE YOU. KEEP TAPE STRAIGHT, BUT NOT TIGHT. MEASURE OVER UNDERGARMENTS OR OTHER CLOTHING TO BE WORN UNDER YOUR UNIFORM.

- 1. HEIGHT: STAND STRAIGHT AGAINST WALL IN STOCKING FEET. MAKE A MARK LEVEL WITH TOP OF HEAD. MEASURE FROM THIS POINT DOWN TO THE FLOOR
- 2. CHEST: WELL UP UNDER ARMS ACROSS SHOULDER BLADES AND OVER FULLEST PART. HOLD TAPE FIRM BUT NOT TIGHT. BE SURE TAPE IS STRAIGHT ACROSS BACK AND KEEP IT LEVEL. STAND NATURALLY.
- 3. WAIST: MEASURE OVER SHIRT (BUT NOT OVER TROUSERS) AT THE POSITION YOU NORMALLY WEAR YOUR SLACKS. HOLD TAPE FIRM BUT NOT TIGHT. OR MEASURE THE WAISTBAND OF A WELL-FITTING PAIR OF SLACKS (ZIPPED UP AND CLOSED) OF THE SAME STYLE.
- **4. NECK:** MEASURE AROUND NECK WHERE SHIRT THAT IS BUTTONED WOULD FIT. BE SURE TAPE MEASURE IS NEITHER TIGHT ENOUGH TO CHOKE OF LOOSE ENOUGH TO SAG.
- 5. SLEEVE: MEASURE FROM MIDDLE OF BACK OF NECK AT POINT 5 ACROSS THE SHOULDER AND AROUND POINT OF ELBOW TO WRISTBONE AT POINT 6
- **6. INSEAM:** MEASURE WELL-FITTING SLACKS OF SAME STYLE ALONG INNER SEAM FROM CROTCH SEAM AT POINT 7 TO BOTTOM OF LEG AT POINT 8. STYLES WORN WITH HIGHER HEELS REQUIRE EXTRA LENGTH.
- 7. RISE: TROUSERS ARE SOMETIMES MADE IN SHORT, REGULAR, AND LONG THIS REFERS TO RISE AND IS ILLUSTRATED IN POINT 9.





- 1. HEIGHT: STAND STRAIGHT AGAINST WALL IN STOCKING FEET. MAKE A MARK LEVEL WITH TOP OF HEAD. MEASURE FROM THIS POINT DOWN TO THE FLOOR. (SHOE HEELS CAN ADD INCHES TO YOUR HEIGHT).
- 2. BUST: MEASURE AROUND FULLEST PART OF BUST, HOLDING TAPE GENTLY. KEEP TAPE STRAIGHT AND LEVEL.
- 3. WAIST: MEASURE AROUND THE SMALLEST PART OF NATURAL WAISTLINE, HOLD TAPE FIRM, BUT NOT TIGHT. KEEP TAPE LEVEL AND BE SURE TO STAND NATURALLY.
- **4. HIPS:** MEASURE AROUND THE FULLEST PART OF HIPS. HOLD THE TAPE MEASURE FIRM, BUT NOT TOO TIGHT. KEEP THE TAPE MEASURE STRAIGHT AND LEVEL.
- **5. OUTSEAM:** PUT ON THE SHOES YOU PLAN ON WEARING. MEASURE FROM 3 TO 5, OR EXACTLY WHERE YOU WOULD LIKE YOUR SLACKS TO HIT ON YOUR SHOE.
- **6. SLEEVE**: MEASURE FROM POINT 6 AT BACK OF NECK BRINGING TAPE OVER POINT OF SHOULDER TO POINT 7 ON WRIST WHERE YOU WOULD LIKE SLEEVE TO HIT.







CARE INSTRUCTIONS

General Maintenance -Dacron and Wool Garments

From: "A Guide To Keep Your Uniform Looking Better Longer" ©1978, Raeford Uniform Fabrics Company.

- Brush your uniform regularly to remove surface dirt.
- When wet, don't dry uniform in direct sun or near extreme heat.
- When not in use, hang your uniform coat and trousers on wooden hangers.
 Trousers should be hung at full length by cuffs.
- Avoid carrying pointed, sharp or heavy objects in pockets.
- Your uniform is a valuable asset . . . entrust it only to a quality establishment for cleaning and pressing.
- Have more than one uniform and alternate wearings. This will substantially
 extend the life of your uniform.

The Problem of Perspiration

Perspiration can have a harmful effect on fabrics. It can result in loss of fabric strength. To prevent this from developing, the following precautions should be taken:

- Dry cleaning solvents do not remove perspiration from a fabric. Affected areas should be called to the attention of your dry cleaner; he will flush them with moisture from a steam spotting gun prior to dry cleaning.
- Although worsted and worsted blend fabrics may not be launderable, a perspiration-affected area may be placed over a towel and blotted with a damp sponge. The area should then be blotted vigorously between two dry towels and hung to air dry.
- For extreme cases, dress shields and the substitution of "T" shirts for sleeveless undershirts, are recommended.

What to do About Spots and Stains

The following procedures are simple procedures for removing or reducing common stains from uniform fabrics utilizing common household items

NOTE: Most chemicals listed above for spot removal are flammable and should be used in a well ventilated area free of any open flame. After treatment air dry — never dry in a tumble dryer.

NOTE: 1. All work should be done with a clean blotter underneath the stain area. 2. "Feathering-out" prevents ringing and is done be starting outside the stain area and lightly brushing towards the center.

NOTE: These care procedures are provided only as a service and should not be interpreted as a warranty, implied or otherwise.

Dacron/Cotton and Dacron/Rayon Permanent Press Garments

- Machine Wash Garments in warm water (DO NOT USE BLEACH), tumble dry (on a permanent press setting), remove promptly. Hang up so that wrinkle will fall out, for touch up use a warm iron.
- For stains spray a pre-wash on soiled area and then wash as instructed above.
- Dry Clean periodically to sharpen creases.

Nylon Garments

We recommend you Dry Clean Only. For stains wash stained area with mild soap and warm water.

Care and Maintenance of Uniform Hats

- Hats should be brushed with a long, softly brisled brush.
- When hat is temporarily not in use, it should be placed crown down on a clean, flat surface.
- When hat is not in use, it should be placed back in the box. Make sure the cord
 and chin strap are removed. The press-stay should always be placed on the hat,
 as this will assure the rigidness and straightness of the brim.
- Rain covers should always be kept handy for inclement weather. If possible, the cover should be used prior to rain, snow, etc.
- If hat becomes damp from perspiration, the inside leather should be turned out, and the hat should be set on the leather.
- If hat becomes water soaked, (sudden shower, dropping in puddle, etc.) it should be dried naturally, removing the braid and strap, and placing on a clean surface
- In case of oil staining or spotting, any commercial fabric spot remover will be appropriate. Place the liquid on a soft, dry rag, letting it evaporate almost completely before using it to clean the hat. (Remember that the spot remover's vapors, not the liquid itself, does the actual removing.) Feather out toward the edges of the stain.

GOOD RULES TO FOLLOW TO PRESERVE YOUR HAT

- Hats should be alternated in use. Recommended procedure is every couple of days in temperatures exceeding 80°, and once a week is sufficient in cooler weather.
- Experience nationwide has proven that the best way to enter and leave the squad car is with the hat in your hand. Remember when you enter the squad car to place the hat where it will not be in a sitting area.
- When storing the hat, place in a cool, dry place.
- You are now wearing the finest trooper headwear available. If you follow these
 few suggestions, you will be proud of your appearance, and the impression you
 convey to others.
