

OLYMPIC NATIONAL PARK

HOH RAIN FOREST

VISITOR CENTER: Open 9 AM - 6:30 PM July and August
9 AM - 4 PM September thru June

Telephone and restrooms available at all hours.
See bulletin boards for schedule of guided walks and campground programs.

CAMPGROUND: Fee is \$10.00 per night (\$5.00 with Golden Age Passport.) Locate a vacant site in an open campground loop, then register at the bulletin board next to restroom.

TRAILS: Nature trails start behind the Visitor Center.

Backpackers must obtain a Backcountry Use Permit at the Visitor Center. After hours registration available. Please park in the Hiker Parking Area. *No pets, weapons, vehicles, or bicycles on trails.*

REGULATIONS: Pets must be kept on leash at all times. No pets on trails or in public buildings.

Do not feed birds or animals. Animals that have been fed become aggressive.

Store food in your vehicle and put garbage in a garbage can.

Fishing regulations are available at the Visitor Center.

CAUTIONS: *SECURE YOUR VALUABLES AGAINST THEFT.* Car break-ins can occur.

Boating and swimming are not advisable in the Hoh River within the park. This glacier-fed river is swift and very cold. In places the channel is blocked by log jams; boaters and swimmers have washed under logs and become trapped.
