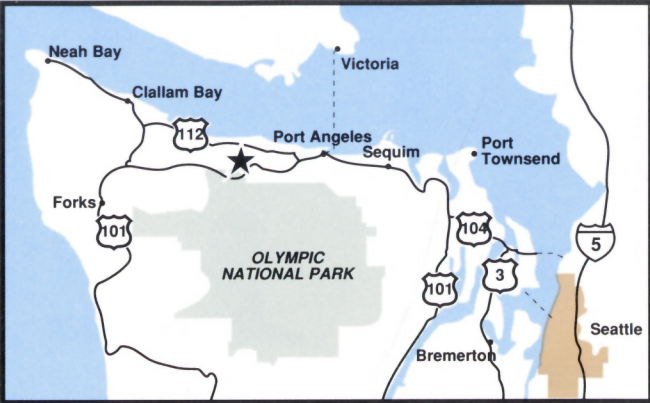




Located on the "sunny side" of Lake Crescent in Olympic National Park.

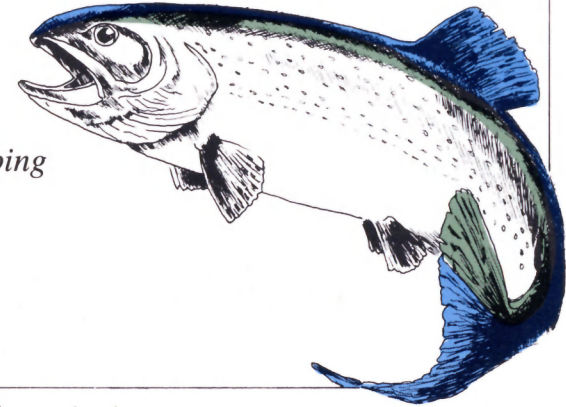
Or try your luck fishing for the elusive Beardslee trout, the ultimate Northwest trophy!

- ☐ **LODGE ROOM:** Non-smoking rooms, adjacent to the lodge, with lake and mountain view, two queen beds and private bathroom with shower. **No cooking, no pets. Maximum four persons.**

- ☐ **CHALET:** Located along the shoreline with lake and mountain view. Main room has a double bed and sofa bed, kitchen sink and refrigerator: **No cooking or eating utensil are provided;** Private bathroom with shower. Upstairs loft with double bed. Outside barbecue and picnic table. **No pets. Maximum six persons. Non-Smoking Rooms.**

- ☐ **CABIN WITH KITCHENETTE:** Individual rustic cabins built in 1928 with lake and/or mountain view. Private bathroom with either a tub or shower. Kitchenette has stove/oven, sink, refrigerator. **No cooking or eating utensils are provided.**

MAINTAINING THE PARK'S TRANQUILITY: Guest units have neither phones, radios or televisions. Pets allowed in **CABINS ONLY**, **\$5.55** per pet per night. Your accommodation should be ready for occupancy by 4:00 p.m. of arrival date; however should the room be ready earlier, it will be available for occupancy.

☐ **PETS:** Dogs and cats are allowed at sites. They must be quiet and cleaned up after. They may not be left alone at site. Pets are not permitted on trails or in the back country. They must be kept on a leash at all times. Pets causing problems will be turned over to the park rangers
