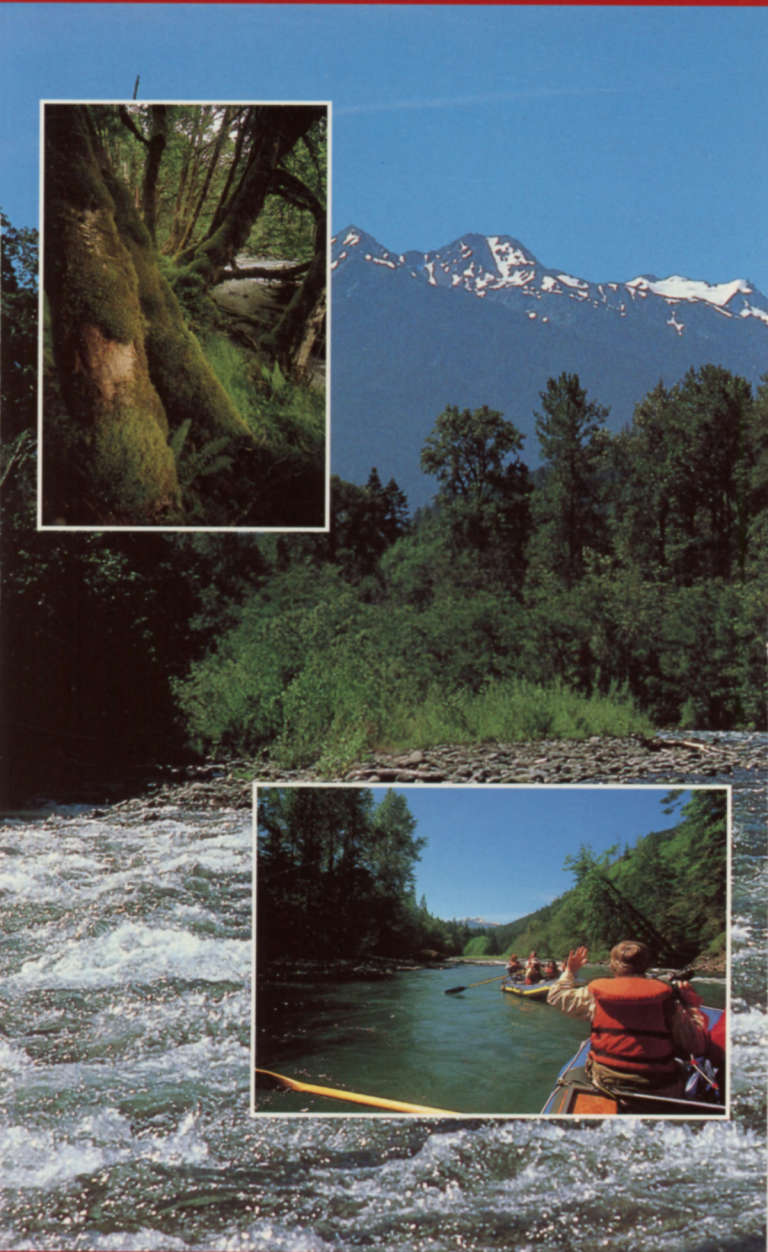


River Rafting in the Olympic National Park

Come Join Us... on one of the beautiful and serene rivers of the Olympic Peninsula. Our trips are recommended for all ages.

Elwha River: This is a Class II, beginning whitewater trip in the Olympic National Park. It is 2 - 2½ hours in length and a perfect way to spend the morning or afternoon enjoying the flora, fauna and scenery of the Olympic Peninsula. Trips depart from the Elwha Resort 8 mi West of Port Angeles on Hwy 101 at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. daily April through mid-September. Plan to arrive ½ hour early for life jacket fitting, etc. Reservations are highly recommended. \$35 per person plus tax.

Hoh River: This is a Class I scenic float (no whitewater) which is 2 - 2½ hours in length. This trip takes you through the Oxbow Canyon, known for its interesting geological formations and dense, lush forest. Conveniently close to the famous Hoh Rain Forest. Trips depart from the R&R Sports Center/Burger Shack 6 miles east of Highway 101 on the Upper Hoh Road at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. daily June through mid-September. Plan to arrive ½ hour early for life jacket fitting, etc. Reservations are highly recommended. \$35 per person plus tax.

Queets River: Overnight trips available on this remote, Class I (no whitewater) river. While lazily floating through the Olympic National Park, you experience abundant wildlife, old homesteads, and beautiful scenery. Please call for details.
