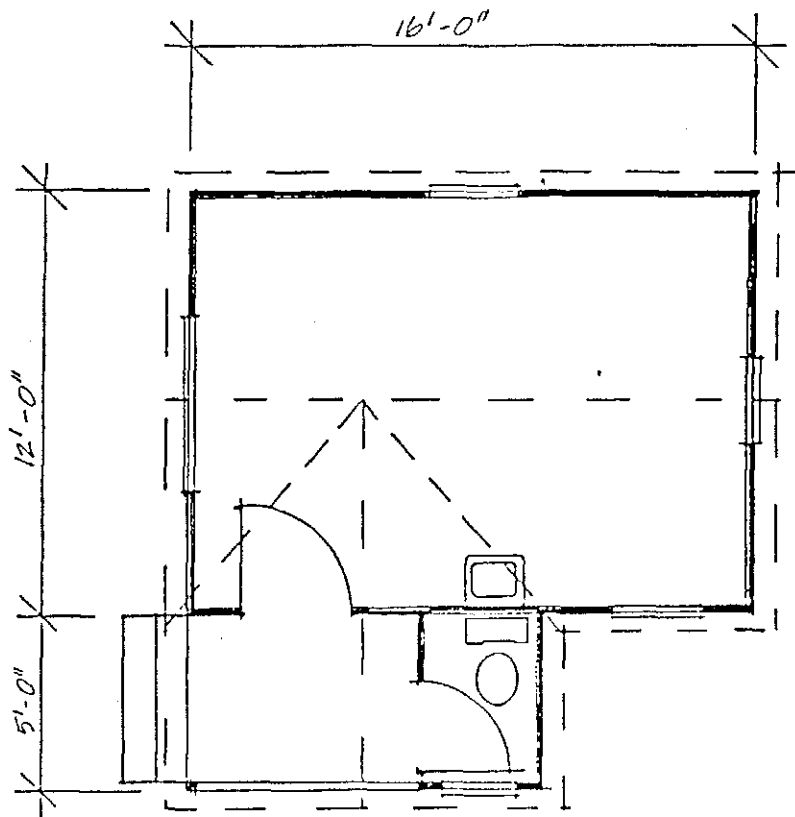

SIGNIFICANCE (architectural and historical, include original use of structure) This cabin was constructed as an integral part of the Rosemary Inn Complex. It contributes to the overall character of the rustic, picturesque resort ensemble and possesses integrity of design, materials, workmanship, location, setting, feeling and association.		
STYLE (if appropriate) Craftsman-style cottage		
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (include structural systems) Wood-frame construction set on 6 x 6 posts on concrete piers.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (sketched floor plans on separate sheet acceptable) L-shape: 17' x 16'		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE 1-story; wood-shingled gable roof with extended eaves and exposed rafter ends; decorative knee braces at gable ends; staggered wood shingle siding with vertical boards above at gable ends (boards staggered); multi-paned casement sash flanked by sidelights; multi-paned hinged sash; plain fascia and corner boards; sill board with lattice skirting below; entry porch on south facade with lattice screening.
