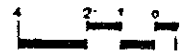
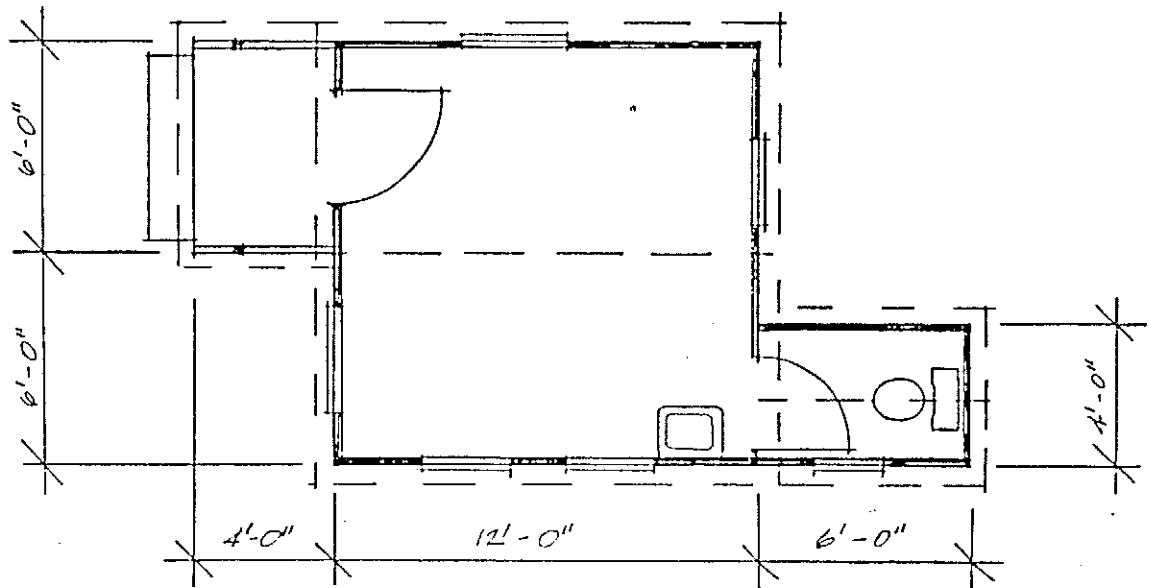

SIGNIFICANCE (architectural and historical, include original use of structure) This cabin was constructed as an integral part of the Rosemary Inn Complex. It contributes to the overall character of the rustic, picturesque resort ensemble and possesses integrity of design, materials, workmanship, location, setting, feeling and association.		
STYLE (if appropriate) Craftsman-style cottage		
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (include structural systems) Wood-frame construction set on 6 x 6 posts on concrete piers; concrete blocks under porch.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (sketched floor plans on separate sheet acceptable) Rectangle: 12' x 16' with a 4' x 6' extension on east.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE 1-story; wood-shingled gable roof with extended eaves, knee braces and exposed rafter ends; shed-roofed entry overhang on west supported by curved knee braces; vertical board and batten siding with wood shingle above; multi-paned hinged sash with plain trim; entry porch has open "stickwork" screening set on vertical board and batten boxed rails; plain corner and fascia boards.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (describe floor plans if not sketched) Painted floor boards; vertical board wainscoting on walls.
